

RESOLUTION NO. RES-06-0099

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LONG BEACH CALLING A PUBLIC HEARING TO DETERMINE WHETHER IT IS IN THE GENERAL PUBLIC INTEREST TO FORM AN UNDERGROUND UTILITY DISTRICT ON WILLOW STREET FROM THE WESTERLY CITY LIMIT TO ATLANTIC AVENUE

WHEREAS, the Long Beach Municipal Code establishes a procedure for the creation of underground utility districts and requires, as one of the initial steps in such procedure, the holding of a public hearing to ascertain whether it is in the general public interest to replace utility poles, overhead wires and associated overhead structures with the underground installation of wires and facilities for supplying electric, communication, or similar or associated service in any such district; and

WHEREAS, it has been recommended that such an underground utility district, hereinafter called "District 40", be formed on Willow Street from the westerly city limit to Atlantic Avenue;

NOW, THEREFORE, the City Council of the City of Long Beach resolves as follows:

Section 1. NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that a public hearing will be held by the City Council of the City of Long Beach on October 10, 2006, at the hour of 5:00 p.m., in the Council Chambers on the Plaza Level of the City Hall, 333 West Ocean Boulevard, in the City of Long Beach, County of Los Angeles, State of California, to ascertain whether it is in the general public interest to replace utility poles, overhead wires and associated overhead structures with the underground installation of wires and facilities used for the transmission of electric energy and other associated services in the District hereinabove described.
