### FIRST AMENDMENT TO AGREEMENT FOR SERVICES

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THIS FIRST AMENDMENT TO AGREEMENT FOR SERVICES is entered into on Journal Queen the CITY OF LONG BEACH, CALIFORNIA, ("City"), and the LONG BEACH HOUSING DEVELOPMENT COMPANY, a California corporation, ("Company"), pursuant to a minute order adopted by the City Council of the City of Long Beach on January 18, 2011.

#### Recitals:

- A. On November 15, 1989, the City and Company entered into an Agreement for Services (the "Agreement").
- B. The parties desire to modify the terms and conditions of the Agreement.

#### THE PARTIES AGREE as follows:

- Section 1. Section 1 of the Agreement is hereby amended to read as follows:
- "1. Services. Company agrees to complete the projects described in Exhibit "A" attached hereto (the "Projects"), provided however, that the total amount paid pursuant to this Agreement shall not exceed \$138,500,000.00. City shall provide all necessary services of the City's employees, City facilities, contractors and other services of the City in order to assist Company in completing the Projects. In the event that a specific project becomes infeasible for any reason, or can be completed for less than the amount indicated in Exhibit "A," the Company may substitute an additional project of the same or lesser cost, provided, that the additional project(s) are consistent with the City's programmatic approval described in Section 2 below."
- Section 2. Section 2 of the Agreement is hereby amended to read as follows:
- "2. <u>Funding for Company Activities.</u> City hereby agrees to pay Company the amount of \$138,500,000.00 in order to fund the Company's activities pursuant

to this Agreement. City agrees that said sum shall be payable out of any tax
increment set-aside funds transferred to the City from the Redevelopment Agency
of the City of Long Beach, California ("Agency") pursuant to that certain
Agreement for Services entered into between the City and Agency dated January
20, 2011, as such funds are received, until the amount is paid in full, or until
September 30, 2021, whichever date occurs first. Company agrees that activities
performed under this Agreement shall be subject to annual programmatic approval
by the City."
Section 3 Export as expressly set forth herein, the terms and conditions of the

Section 3. Except as expressly set forth herein, the terms and conditions of the Agreement shall remain in full force and effect.

THE PARTIES have executed this First Amendment to Agreement for Services as of the date first provided above.
