A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LONG BEACH, CALIFORNIA, ORDERING, PROCLAIMING, CALLING AND GIVING NOTICE OF A PRIMARY NOMINATING ELECTION AND A GENERAL MUNICIPAL ELECTION IN THE CITY OF LONG BEACH, CALIFORNIA, ON TUESDAY, THE 7TH DAY OF JUNE, 2022, AND THE 8TH DAY OF NOVEMBER, 2022, RESPECTIVELY, FOR THE NOMINATION ELECTION OF CANDIDATES FOR FIVE (5) OFFICES OF THE LONG BEACH CITY COUNCIL, FOUR (4) CITY OFFICIALS, AND THREE (3) OFFICES OF THE LONG BEACH UNIFIED SCHOOL DISTRICT, EACH FOR A FULL TERM OF FOUR (4) YEARS, COMMENCING WITH THE THIRD TUESDAY OF DECEMBER, 2022, AND ADOPTING PROVISIONS RELATING TO THE TRANSLATIONS OF AND THE CHARGES FOR COSTS OF CANDIDATE **STATEMENTS**

WHEREAS, the Long Beach City Charter requires that the City Council shall, by resolution, order the holding of all municipal elections; and

WHEREAS, Long Beach Municipal Code Chapter 1.15 changed the regular election dates of the Primary Nominating Election and the General Municipal Election to March and November respectively, to coincide with statewide elections as required by SB 415; and

WHEREAS, the Long Beach Municipal Code mandates that the City's primary elections shall be held on the first Tuesday after the first Monday in March in

even-numbered years, and general elections shall be held on the first Tuesday after the first Monday in November; and

WHEREAS, Resolution No. RES-21-0045 of the City of Long Beach approved moving its primary and general municipal election dates to align with the statewide general election dates for 2022 set for June 7, 2022 and November 8, 2022; and

WHEREAS, Elections Code Section 13307 provides that before a local election nominating period opens, the local agency for that election shall make a determination concerning the levy of the costs for candidate statements;

NOW, THEREFORE, the City Council of the City of Long Beach resolves as follows:

Section 1. Pursuant to the provisions of the laws of the State of California and pursuant to the provisions of the Charter of the City of Long Beach governing the holding of Primary Nominating Elections in the City, a Primary Nominating Election is hereby ordered, proclaimed, declared, and called to be held in the City of Long Beach on June 7, 2022, for the purpose of nominating candidates for and/or electing persons for five (5) offices on the City Council, namely, for the First, Third, Fifth, Seventh and Ninth Districts, four (4) City Officials, namely, the Mayor, City Attorney, City Auditor, and City Prosecutor; and a General Municipal Election on November 8, 2022, for a full term of four (4) years commencing with the third Tuesday of December, 2022; and notice is given of the holding of this election and of the time and place of holding the same.

Section 2. Pursuant to the Charter of the City of Long Beach and the California Education and Election Codes, and by Resolution No. 011922-A the Governing Board of the Long Beach Unified School District, a Primary Nominating Election is hereby ordered, proclaimed, declared and called to be held, and consolidated with the City's and County's Primary Nominating Election, for the election of three (3) members of the Governing Board from School Board Districts 1, 3 and 5 of the Long Beach Unified School District, for a full term of four (4) years commencing with the third

Tuesday of December, 2022, and notice is given of the holding of this election, and of the time and place of holding the same.

Section 3. California Elections Code Section 13307 requires that a candidate's statement be translated in Spanish at the candidate's request. Further, in accordance with the requirements of the federal Voting Rights Act of 1965 (PL 94-73) all candidates' statements shall be translated into the languages required thereby. Accordingly, candidates' statements for all offices shall be translated into Spanish, Tagalog, Khmer, Vietnamese and Korean. Any translations into the required languages shall be available in the City Clerk's Department upon request. A candidate shall not be required to pay for the cost of translating his or her candidate's statement into any foreign language required pursuant to federal and/or state law. However, a candidate shall be required to pay for the cost of printing the candidate's statement in Spanish.

Section 4. Pursuant to Section 13307 of the California Elections Code, a charge shall be levied against each candidate for the costs of the candidate's statement sent to each voter. The City Clerk is directed and authorized to establish and implement the charge for the costs of printing, handling, and mailing any candidate statements as provided in Elections Code Section 13307. Any allegation of indigency or inability to pay the requisite fee in advance shall be handled by the City Clerk in accordance with the provisions of Elections Code Section 13309, and in such instances the candidate's statement shall only be published in the English language.

Section 5. No candidate will be permitted to include any additional materials in any sample ballot booklet.

The City Clerk shall provide each candidate or the candidate's Section 6. representative with a copy of this resolution at the time nominating papers are issued.

Section 7. This resolution shall take effect immediately upon its adoption by the City Council, and the City Clerk shall certify the vote adopting this resolution.

A RESOLUTION OF THE GOVERNING BOARD OF EDUCATION
OF THE LONG BEACH UNIFIED SCHOOL DISTRICT OF LOS ANGELES COUNTY
ORDERING A GOVERNING BOARD MEMBER PRIMARY ELECTION,
SETTING FORTH THE SPECIFICATIONS OF THE ELECTION ORDER,
AND REQUESTING CONSOLIDATION OF SUCH ELECTIONS WITH
THE PRIMARY NOMINATING MUNICIPAL ELECTIONS
TO BE HELD ON JUNE 7, 2022 IN THE CITY OF LONG BEACH

WHEREAS, California Education Code section 5200 and following provide that the election of Governing Board Members of the Long Beach Unified School District shall be governed by the provisions of the Long Beach City Charter; and

WHEREAS, Chapter 1.15 of City of Long Beach Municipal Code provides that beginning in 2020 the primary nominating election for Governing Board Members of the Long Beach Unified School District be held in even-numbered years, on the first Tuesday after the first Monday in March;

WHEREAS, on May 14, 2019, the Los Angeles County Board of Supervisors approved Long Beach Unified School District's request pursuant to Elections Code section 1302 to hold its Primary Nominating Elections on the first Tuesday after the first Monday in March of even-numbered years, and its General Municipal Elections to the first Tuesday after the first Monday in November of even numbered years, consolidated with the statewide elections conducted by Los Angeles County, effective March 2020;

WHEREAS, the city of Long Beach has scheduled primary nominating municipal elections to be held on June 7, 2022, for the election of City officers pursuant to the provisions of law of the State of California, the same day as the Long Beach Unified School District nominating elections; and

WHEREAS, the primary nominating municipal elections of the city named will be conducted in territorywhich is in part the same as the territory within which the school district primary election will be held; and

WHEREAS, the Governing Board of the Long Beach Unified School District desires that the school district primary election scheduled for June 7, 2022 be consolidated with the primary nominating municipal elections of the city named also scheduled June 7, 2022 and that such be done in accordance with provisions of the California Education and Elections Codes; and

WHEREAS, such consolidation will result in an election which is both efficient in expenditure of tax dollars and convenient for voters;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Governing Board of the Long Beach Unified School District does hereby determine, order, and resolve as follows:

- 1. That pursuant to provisions of the California Education Code, the County Superintendentof Schools of Los Angeles County is hereby directed to call an election to be held in the Long Beach Unified School District on June 7, 2022, for the purpose of conducting a primary election for the election of three members of the Governing Board from School Board districts 1, 3 and 5 of the Long Beach Unified School District.
- 2. That pursuant to the Charter of the City of Long Beach and the California Education and Election Codes, the specifications of the election order shall provide that the primary election to be held on June 7, 2022 is for the purpose of determining which candidate shall be elected from each School

Board district by reason of obtaining a majority of the votes cast at the primary election, or in the event no candidate obtains a majority of votes cast, which two candidates of the School Board district who, having received the greatest number of votes at the primary election, shall thereafter stand for election at the general election November 8, 2022; and that the terms of office shall be for four years for members elected from School Board districts 1, 3 and 5, which terms shall commence on December 20, 2022. Any ties in voting shall be settled by the casting of lots under the supervision of the Los Angeles County Registrar-Recorder, and in such manner and place as the Los Angeles County Registrar-Recorder decides.

- 3. That, in accordance with provisions of the Education and Elections Codes, the governing body of the city of Long Beach, be and hereby is requested to consolidate the school district primary election of June 7, 2022 with the primary nominating municipal elections of the city named for March 3, 2022.
- 4. That, in accordance with California Elections Code sections 10400 *et seq.*, the Governing Board of the Long Beach Unified School District consents to the further consolidation of the City's municipal election with that of Los Angeles County.
- 5. That the election precincts, the polling places and voting booths, the polling hours and the officers appointed to conduct the election shall, to the extent possible, be the same as those provided for the municipal elections to be held in the above-named city.
- 6. That the respective governing bodies of the above-named city be and is hereby authorized to canvas the returns of said school district election which is being consolidated with the primary nominating municipal elections, and certify the election results to the Los Angeles County Registrar-Recorder.
- 7. That the school district election, as consolidated with the elections held in the above-named city, shall be held, to the extent possible, as if there were only one election held in the city, and, to the extent possible, only one form of the ballot shall be used.
- 8. That the governing bodies of the above-named city is hereby requested to take any and all steps necessary for the holding of said consolidated elections.
- 9. That the Long Beach Unified School District agrees to pay to the entity conducting each election any additional costs which are incurred by such entity as a result of this consolidation.
- 10. That a certified copy of this Resolution be filed by the Secretary of the Board of Education with the governing body of the above-named city, as well as the Los Angeles County Superintendent of Schools, and the Los Angeles County Registrar-Recorder.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED THAT, the Board of Education adopt Resolution No. 011922-A ordering a primary election for the Board of Education members of districts 1, 3 and 5 and consolidation of such election with the primary nominating municipal election to be held on June 7, 2022 in the city of Long Beach.
