Subject: Status Update – Judicious Opioid Prescribing

On October 10, 2017, the City Council directed the City Manager and Department of Health and Human Services (Health Department) to report back in 30 days with a status report on the feasibility, strategy, and potential benefits of conducting a public health campaign promoting judicious opioid prescribing by Long Beach physicians and other applicable healthcare staff.

The Health Department is continuing to research this multi-faceted issue and is preparing a response to this item. We anticipate submitting our findings by February 15, 2018.
