One year recent active experience identifying and rolling fingerprints in a recognized law enforcement agency that uses the FBI method of identifying and rolling fingerprints, may be substituted for completion of the fingerprint identification course.

Proof of a valid Class C motor vehicle operator's license and a current DMV driving record must be submitted to the hiring department at time of selection interview.

DESIRABLE QUALIFICATIONS: Knowledge of the methods used and the ability to roll and identify fingerprints for the purpose of identification. Computer skills.

EXAMPLES OF DUTIES: Under general supervision, performs technical and clerical work in identifying and searching for fingerprints via an automated fingerprint system; searches and compares fingerprints with existing fingerprint records to establish identity; compares fingerprints in electronic databases and on pawn tickets, citations and registrants (Narcotics, Arson and Sex) to

establish positive identification; prepares fingerprint records for exchange with other law enforcement agencies; processes paperwork for checking warrants and clearing subjects for release; rolls and compares fingerprints for court testimony and may be required to testify in court regarding fingerprint findings; occasionally rolls fingerprints of suspects for identification purposes; performs other related duties as required.

A minimum rating of 70 must be attained in order to pass the examination. Certification by score bands will be considered based on an analysis of test results.

REQUIREMENTS TO FILE: Seven years (full-time equivalent) of paid experience as a plumber, two years of which must have been in a supervisory capacity. **Applicant must also meet one of the following options below:**

- A.) L.A. City Journeyman Plumber License (proof required)* **OR**
- B.) County of L.A. Plumbing License (proof required)* **OR**
- C.) A valid State of California Plumbing Contractor's License/C-36 (proof required)*
- D.) National Inspection Testing Certification (formally P.I.P.E.) (proof required)*
- E.) Plumbing Heating Cooling Contractors License (proof required)*.

Willingness and ability to work standby, overtime, emergency call-outs and weekends as required.

A valid driver's license will be required at time of appointment.

DESIRABLE QUALIFICATIONS: Two or more years of supervisory experience; State of California Plumbing Contractor's License; Knowledge of the Uniform Plumbing Code; California Plumbing Code or L.A. City Plumbing Code; Knowledge of irrigation sewer, storm drain, and portable water distribution systems; a valid Backflow Prevention Device Inspection Certificate.

****If appointed, candidates will be required to successfully complete a backflow prevention training course and obtain a valid Backflow Device Inspection Certificate within six months after appointment. Also, if appointed, candidates will be required to attend training on the handling of asbestos and lead.**

EXAMPLES OF DUTIES: Under direction, plans, supervises and participates in the work of journey level plumbers and helpers engaged in the installation, repair and maintenance of heating, water, disposal, natural gas and drainage systems; determines work to be done from blueprints, plans and specifications or job site inspection; estimates material and labor costs; lays out, assigns, supervises and examines the work of subordinates; inspects facilities to determine plumbing needs; orders supplies and materials, plans and designs plumbing installations; establishes operating procedures and work standards; develops and maintains safe working practices and enforces safety regulations; assists in the selection and evaluation of subordinates; keeps records, prepares routine reports and assists in preparation of the annual budget; and performs other related duties as required.

EXAMINATION WEIGHTS:

Screening of candidates will be conducted on the basis of applications and supplemental applications submitted. Only those candidates showing the strongest backgrounds in a comparative analysis will be admitted to the appraisal interview. The interview will have a weight of 100% and will evaluate the candidates' work experience, education, training and personal qualifications. A minimum rating of 70 must be attained in order to pass the examination. Certification by score bands may be considered based on an analysis of test results. Based on the number of applications accepted, a qualifying written examination may be given.

REQUIREMENTS TO FILE: Applicants must meet the following requirements:

- Twenty years of age or older at time of filing.
- U.S. High school graduate or G.E.D. equivalency*.
- Valid driver's license*.
- U.S. Citizenship or have applied for citizenship. Citizenship must be granted within three years of appointment.
- No felony convictions.
- Ability to make sound decisions and read, comprehend and retain technical training materials; endure periods of strenuous physical activity requiring good balance, coordination, flexibility, endurance and strength.
- Possess good observation, writing, communication and human relation skills.
- Be compassionate, culturally sensitive, non-discriminatory to a diverse population.
- Possess good leadership and public service qualities.
- Ability to exercise tact using excellent interpersonal skills, solve problems, and demonstrate good mediation skills during highly confrontational situations.

*Do not attach proof of the requirements to file with your application. Proof will be required at the time of conditional offer of employment.

DESIRABLE QUALIFICATIONS: Recent college coursework in related fields. Bilingual language ability (Spanish, Khmer, or Tagalog) is desirable for some positions.

EXAMPLES OF DUTIES: Under immediate supervision in a non-sworn training capacity, develops minimum qualifications required for a career in police service; receives Police Academy instruction in Police Department policies and procedures, weaponless defense, criminal and civil law, physical fitness techniques, use of firearms, arrest procedures, community relations, operation of emergency vehicles and other mandated courses; observes sworn police personnel in the processing of

arrestees, including booking, fingerprinting, custody and control; may perform non-sworn police support functions, such as traffic and crowd control, as directed during the training process.

SELECTION PROCEDURE: This exam will be conducted using the continuous, open-competitive procedure.

(NTN: Human Relations, Written Language, Reading and Comprehension)

The written examination will be administered by the National Testing Network (NTN). The examination is NTN's Entry Level Law Enforcement Test entitled "FrontLine National". The deadline to complete the written examination through NTN is January 17, 2016. Applicants must schedule a testing date through nationaltestingnetwork.com. There is no need to fill out a Personal History Questionnaire (PHQ) through NTN and/or take a Physical Ability Test (PAT) as these two processes will be given by the Long Beach Police Department at a later date. In order to complete the application process, candidates must take the NTN exam and complete the online application.

POLICE RECRUIT- POST WAIVER CANDIDATES: The NTN written examination will be waived for candidates who have taken the POST Entry-Level Law Enforcement Test Battery (PELLETB) examination with an approved agency and achieved a T-score of 45 or above within one year of the time of filing (proof required). Applicants submitting the PELLETB examination score must complete the application for Police Recruit-POST WAIVER.

REQUIREMENTS TO FILE: Two years of full-time equivalent journey-level experience as a general welder.

Current Structural Welding Certificate recognized by the American Welding Society (proof required)*.

Ability to work independently; handle multiple deadlines at once; reprioritize workload, as necessary.

Willingness to work weekends, nights, holidays, overtime and on-call as required.

A Class B driver's license may be required for some positions.

***Proof of required documents must be uploaded to the online application at time of filing.**

EXAMPLES OF DUTIES: Under general supervision, utilizes arc, oxyacetylene, metal inert gas (MIG), and/or heliarc processes in performing a variety of welding assignments in the field and in the shop; utilizes oxyacetylene, plasma, and air arc cutters for cutting processes; repairs fabricates and installs parts for equipment, machinery, piping, tools and other metal objects in accordance with appropriate industry standards; observes and enforces safety rules and regulations; fabricates water spools, meter lids, and specialty tools; repairs aluminum trailer ramps (tig weld aluminum); provides services to different sections within

department; may operate metal press brake and metal shearing equipment; and performs other related duties as required.

SELECTION PROCEDURE:

Application and Supplemental Application.....Qualifying

This process will be conducted using the continuous, non-competitive procedure. Applicants may only apply once during a four month period. The eligible list will remain in effect for at least 6 months. All applicants meeting the minimum requirements to file will be placed on the eligible list, with those receiving Veteran's Credit first and then in the order in which applications were filed. Screening of candidates will be conducted on the basis of application packets submitted. Eligible lists may be established periodically.
