Subject: Presentation on Miller Children's and Women's Hospital

RECOMMENDATION:

Receive and file a presentation from John Bishop, Chief Executive Officer, Long Beach Medical Center, to highlight new services provided at the Chereese Mari Laulhere Children's Village (Children's Village) in the Miller Children's and Women's Hospital.

DISCUSSION:

The Children's Village is an 80,000-square-foot building located in the Miller Children's and Women's Hospital, just across from the main hospital entrance. Five clinic locations moved into one building to centralize care and make the experience easier and more convenient for patient.

The purpose of this presentation is to highlight pediatric specialty care and medical and family support services provided at the Children's Village.
