3 A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE  
4 CITY OF LONG BEACH AUTHORIZING ACCEPTANCE OF  
5 GRANT FUNDING FROM THE CALIFORNIA DEPARTMENT  
6 OF TRANSPORTATION FOR AN UPTOWN LONG BEACH  
7 NEIGHBORHOOD MOBILITY ENHANCEMENT PLAN  
8 GRANT IN THE AMOUNT OF \$733,610; AND AUTHORIZING  
9 THE CITY MANAGER OR HIS DESIGNEE TO EXECUTE ANY  
10 DOCUMENTS NECESSARY TO COMPLETE THE PROJECT

12 WHEREAS, the City of Long Beach desires to receive and utilize funds  
13 available through the State of California Department of Transportation (CalTrans) for a  
14 recently awarded Uptown Long Beach Neighborhood Mobility Enhancement Plan Grant.

15 WHEREAS, said grant from CalTrans will fund Phase II work underway in  
16 the Uptown area. This work is a continuation of the UPLAN planning and outreach work  
17 begun in the uptown area of the City in 2017 to revitalize major commercial corridors.

18 NOW, THEREFORE, the City Council of the City of Long Beach resolves as  
19 follows:

20 Section 1. The City Council appoints the City Manager, or designee, as  
21 agent to conduct all negotiations, execute and submit all documents including, but not  
22 limited to applications, agreements, payment requests and so on, which may be  
23 necessary for the acceptance of an Uptown Long Beach Neighborhood Mobility  
24 Enhancement Plan Grant from the California Department of Transportation (CalTrans) in  
25 the amount of \$733,610 to be utilized for, among other things, a planning and mobility  
26 consultant to assist with UPLAN planning and outreach work.

27 Section 2. The City of Long Beach agrees to provide all matching funds  
28 required for said Project in the amount of \$110,060, and abide by the statutes and

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1 regulations governing the CalTrans Uptown Long Beach Neighborhood Mobility  
2 Enhancement Plan Grant, as well as the terms and conditions of the Grant Agreement as  
3 set forth by CalTrans.

4 Section 3. This resolution shall take effect immediately upon its adoption  
5 by the City Council, and the City Clerk shall certify to the vote adopting this resolution.
