DISCUSSION

On November 5, 2013, the City Council adopted a resolution calling and giving notice of the Primary Nominating Election.

With the close of the candidate nomination period on January 10, 2014, the City Clerk is required to submit the attached resolution for adoption pursuant to City Charter Section 1907, which serves to certify the list of candidates who were duly nominated, and identify the order in which their names will appear on the official ballot.

The recommended resolution includes a listing of candidates for contests in the Long Beach Unified School District and the Long Beach Community College District as certified by the Los Angeles County Registrar-Recorder/County Clerk. Candidates for the foregoing contests are listed in the order in which they will appear on the official ballot.

TIMING CONSIDERATIONS

Approval of the recommended action at this time will allow the City Clerk Department to prepare the official ballot, sample ballot and ballot pamphlet.

FISCAL IMPACT

The City Clerk Department budget contains the appropriations necessary for conduct of the April 8, 2014, Primary Nominating Election.

RE: April General Law City Elections: Randomized Alphabet Drawing

In accordance with Elections Code section 13112(b)(1)(A), the Secretary of State's office conducted a drawing of the letters of the alphabet to determine the randomized alphabet for use in the above election. Listed below is the official order of letters for use in determining placement of candidates' names on the ballot.

Please note that this alphabet is to be applied THROUGHOUT the candidate's entire last name, so if more than one candidate's surname begins with the same letter, the second letter of the surname determines who goes first, according to where the second letter of the name appears in the random alphabet. For example, if two candidates with the surname of Campbell and Carlson are running for the same office, their order on the ballot will depend on the order in which the letters "M " and "R" were drawn in the randomized alphabet drawing.
