Provide all labor, materials and equipment necessary to relocate an existing fire hydrant fifteen (15') feet, located on the southeast corner of Ocean Boulevard and Locust Avenue to accommodate Delta 1 plan changes, as directed by the Project Engineer, (C) 2. Provide all labor, materials and equipment necessary to upgrade twelve (12) traffic signal controllers to be compatible with the advance traffic control system, as directed by the Project Engineer, (C) 3. Provide all labor, materials and equipment necessary to remove thermoplastic traffic striping within the Grand Prix race track boundaries at the intersection of Shoreline Drive and Pine Avenue, installed per the construction drawings, as directed by the Project Engineer, In accordance with Section 3-3, Extra Work, of the Standard Specifications for Public Works Construction 2009 Edition, you are authorized to do the following: (C) 4. Provide all labor, materials and equipment necessary to remove an existing non-standard traffic signal pole foundation at the intersection of Ocean Boulevard and Long Beach Boulevard, as directed by the Project Engineer, (C) 5. Provide all labor, materials and equipment necessary to use existing conduit in lieu of the planned micro duct to enter the City Data Center, as directed by the Project Engineer,
