The City Council of the City of Long Beach resolves as follows:

10 Section 1. Pursuant to and in accordance with the provisions of Section 11 34090 of the Government Code of the State of California and Chapter 1.28 of the Long Beach Municipal Code relating to the destruction of City records, and the City Attorney 12 having heretofore given his written consent, the City Council of the City of Long Beach 13 14 does hereby approve and authorize the destruction by the Department of Development 15 Services of any and all of the records, documents, instruments, books, papers, and writings as set forth in the documents attached hereto and marked Exhibit "A" and by 16 17 reference thereto made a part hereof, which records are under its charge and are no 18 longer required for use in its respective office, said records being no less than two (2) 19 vears old.

20 Section 2. The City Council hereby finds that none of said records: 21 Α. Affect the title to real property or liens thereon; 22 Β. Constitute official court records; 23 C. Constitute records which are required to be kept by statute; D. 
