RESOLUTION NO. RES-10-0140

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LONG BEACH PROVIDING FOR A TEMPORARY AMNESTY PROGRAM AND WAIVING CONDITIONAL USE PERMIT AND SITE PLAN REVIEW APPLICATION FEES FOR AUTOMOBILE SALES BUSINESSES LOCATED ON LONG BEACH BOULEVARD BETWEEN WILLOW STREET AND ANAHEIM STREET WITHIN THE LONG BEACH BOULEVARD PLANNED DEVELOPMENT DISTRICT (PD-29)

WHEREAS, on May 15, 2007, the City Council of the City of Long Beach adopted Ordinance No. ORD-07-0021 which amended and restated the Long Beach Boulevard Planned Development District (PD-29) to expand the performance standards for certain automobile sales businesses located on Long Beach Boulevard between Willow Street and Anaheim Street and required all new automobile sales businesses to obtain a Conditional Use Permit and Site Plan Review, and likewise required all then existing automobile sales businesses to apply for, and receive, a Conditional Use Permit no later than May 2009.

WHEREAS, the fees related to the application and processing of Conditional Use Permits and Site Plan Review have proven to be an undue burden to automobile sales businesses that are subject to the provisions of the ordinance, which has stalled efforts to upgrade the Long Beach Boulevard corridor.

WHEREAS, staff recommends a sixty (60) day amnesty period from January 1, 2011 to March 1, 2011, during which time all fees related to Conditional Use Permit and Site Plan Review applications could be waived for those automobile sales businesses not currently in compliance with the existing regulatory ordinance;

1	NOW, THEREFORE, the City Council of the City of Long Beach resolves as
2	follows:
3	Section 1. The Director of Development Services ("Director") shall
4	develop and administer a temporary amnesty program which will waive the application
5	fees for Conditional Use Permits and Site Plan Review for automobile sales businesses
6	located in Subareas 1, 3 and 4 of PD-29 between Willow Street and Anaheim Street for
7	the period of January 1, 2011 to March 1, 2011.
8	Section 2. This resolution shall take effect immediately upon its adoption
9	by the City Council, and the City Clerk shall certify the vote adopting this resolution.
