On behalf of the City of Long Beach, I'd like to thank you for your participation at the March 5, 2009 community meeting on the distribution of Public, Education, and Government (PEG) fee revenue. There was a lot of great discussion on the topic and it was exciting to see the enthusiasm for access television.

As promised, I'm forwarding City staff's report to the City Council. It recommends that PEG fees be equally split across all three (3) access categories (P, E & G). I plan to deliver the staff report to the City Council at their regularly scheduled meeting on Tuesday, April 21, 2009. The meeting begins at 5:00 pm and is held at City Hall, 333 West Ocean Boulevard. I hope that you can be in attendance.
