

FIRST AMENDMENT TO RIGHT-OF-ENTRY PERMIT

THIS FIRST AMENDMENT TO RIGHT-OF-ENTRY PERMIT ("First Amendment") is made this 2nd day of June, 2022 by and between the CITY OF LONG BEACH, a municipal corporation ("City") and CARNIVAL CORPORATION, a Panamanian corporation ("Permittee").

WHEREAS, City and Permittee entered into a Right-of-Entry-Permit dated December 1, 2021 (the "Permit") to allow Permittee the temporary right to occupy a portion of certain real property owned by City commonly known as the Queen Mary parking lot, and more particularly depicted on Exhibit "A" attached to the Permit (the "Premises").

WHEREAS, the parties desire to extend the term of the Permit;

NOW, THEREFORE, in consideration of the mutual terms and conditions in the Permit and this Amendment, the parties agree as follows:

- 1. The term of the Permit is hereby extended for an additional six (6) months commencing on June 11, 2022, and ending on December 10, 2022.
- 2. Except as amended by this Amendment, the Permit remains unchanged and in full force and effect.
- 3. This Amendment shall be effective as of the date executed by City.
