RECOMMENDATION:

Refer to Hearing Officer Appeal to Denial of Business License by Hoa Thuy Hang, DBA Jackie Nails and Spa. 1982 Atlantic Avenue. (District 6)

DISCUSSION

The Department of Financial Management denied the business license application of Hoa Thuy Hang, DBA Jackie Nails and Spa, 1982 Atlantic Avenue, at the recommendation of the Planning and Building Department on the basis of not completing the inspection and permit process for converting a smoke shop to a nail salon (see Attachment A). The business has appealed this decision in a letter dated October 4, 2005 (see Attachment B).

The Long Beach Municipal Code (LBMC) prescribes that the applicant can appeal the denial of a business license application to the City Council within ten days of the denial. In addition, the LBMC prescribes that the City Council, at its next regular meeting or within ten days of the filing of the appeal, shall set the appeal hearing. Whenever it is provided that a hearing shall be heard by the City Council, the City Council may, in its discretion, either conduct the hearing itself or appoint a hearing officer to conduct the hearing.

This matter was reviewed by Deputy City Attorney Cristyl Meyers on October 19, 2005.

TIMING CONSIDERATIONS

LBMC requires that the hearing be set at its next regular meeting or within ten days of receiving the appeal.

FISCAL IMPACT

There is no fiscal impact associated with this item.

SUGGESTED ACTION:
