## RESOLUTION NO. RES-16-0104

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LONG BEACH AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO EXECUTE A CONTRACT WITH THE GORDIAN GROUP, INC., WITHOUT ADVERTISING FOR BIDS, TO PROVIDE JOB ORDER CONTRACTING PROGRAM AND SOFTWARE SUPPORT FOR A TOTAL CONTRACT AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED \$800,000 FOR A PERIOD OF TWO YEARS WITH THE OPTION TO RENEW FOR TWO ADDITIONAL ONE-YEAR PERIODS

WHEREAS, the Department of Public Works requires Job Order Contracting (JOC) program and software support; and

WHEREAS, the JOC system, which utilizes a competitively bid firm-price master contract, is a comprehensive procurement system designed to help public agencies provide routine construction services in a more timely and cost efficient manner than the traditional design/bid/build method of contracting; and

WHEREAS, the City of Long Beach has contracted with The Gordian Group, Inc. (Gordian) since 2003 for use of their proprietary JOC system; and

WHEREAS, the Gordian JOC program is a highly specialized and proprietary solution consisting of e-Gordian web- based JOC applications configured to meet the City's specific needs, Construction Task Catalog customized to include the construction tasks required, implementation services and support materials to train City and construction contractor staff to properly utilize the system, and on-going technical maintenance and support services; and

WHEREAS, Gordian is the only company that provides JOC program support that is both comprehensive and highly integrated and no comparable level of services

WHEREAS, no useful purpose would be served by advertising for bids and to do so would constitute an idle and useless act and an unnecessary expenditure of public funds because The Gordian Group, Inc. is the only corporation, firm or individual that could or would bid to furnish and deliver Job Order Contracting program and software support;

NOW, THEREFORE, the City Council of the City of Long Beach resolves as follows:

Section 1. The City Manager is hereby authorized to enter a contract, without advertising for bids, with The Gordian Group, Inc. for furnishing and delivering Job Order Contracting program and software support for a period of two (2) years, in a total not to exceed amount of Eight Hundred Thousand Dollars (\$800,000). The contract may be extended for two (2) additional one-year periods, at the discretion of the City Manager. If the sole source status of The Gordian Group, Inc. changes, City shall publicly bid instead of extending the contract.

Section 2. This resolution shall take effect immediately upon its adoption by the City Council, and the City Clerk shall certify the vote adopting this resolution.
