## **RESOLUTION NO. C-**

## RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LONG BEACH URGING THE CALIFORNIA STATE LEGISLATURE TO ENACT ASSEMBLY BILL 2041

WHEREAS, Harbor Departments of the Cities of Los Angeles and Long Beach predict that truck traffic to and from the ports of San Pedro Bay will more than double in the next 20 years from roughly 35,000 trucks to nearly 83,000 trucks per day; and

WHEREAS, trucks emit air contaminants and contribute to congestion on local freeways and streets; and

WHEREAS, most trucked cargo currently moves on local freeways and streets during daylight hours; and

WHEREAS, AB 2041 would establish a charge for cargo moving by truck on weekdays between 8:00 a.m. and 5:00 p.m.

NOW, THEREFORE, the City Council of the City of Long Beach resolves as follows:

Section 1. That the City Council supports AB 2041 in order to reduce the contribution of trucks to peak hour congestion.

Sec. 2. That the City Clerk is directed to transmit a copy of this resolution to the Governor, to the members of the California Legislature representing the Long Beach and Los Angeles areas, and any other officials, agencies, entities, and individuals as may be deemed appropriate.

Sec. 3. This resolution shall take effect immediately upon its adoption by the City Council, and the City Clerk shall certify to the vote adopting this resolution.
