- 1. <u>RECITALS</u>: This Third Extension is made and entered into with reference to the following facts and objectives:
- 1.1 Lessor and Standard Oil Company of California, a Delaware corporation ("Standard Oil") entered into a written lease dated as of February 21, 1968 ("Lease") for the lease of certain premises in the City of Long Beach, California ("Premises") to be used for a motor vehicle service station and allied purposes. An Indenture of Lease, in which the Premises are more particularly described, was recorded on September 15, 1968, as Document No. 2770 in Book M2977, Pages 12-14 of the Official Records of Los Angeles County, California.
- 1.2 The Lease was amended by an unrecorded letter agreement datedMay 15, 1968.
- 1.3 Pursuant to the provisions of Paragraph 1 of the Lease, Lessee exercised the option to extend the term of the Lease from February 21, 1993 to February 20, 1998 and thereafter exercised the option to extend the term of the Lease from February 21, 1998 to February 20, 2003.
- 1.4 The Lease was further amended by an unrecorded Extension Agreement dated August 13, 2002 ("First Extension Agreement"), which extended the term from February 21, 2003 to February 20, 2004. The Lease was further amended by an Extension Agreement dated February 13, 2004 ("Second Extension Agreement"), which extended the term from February 21, 2004 through February 20, 2006. The Lease as amended and extended is referred to herein as the "Lease."
