DISCUSSION:

Arcelia Delgado has made a claim for injuries allegedly sustained in the course of her employment with the City of Long Beach. The Economic Development and Finance Committee on September 1, 2009, approved the submission to the Workers' Compensation Appeals Board of Stipulations with Request for Award by the City and Arcelia Delgado, based upon a 49 percent disability rating, with a provision for lifetime medical care as may be necessary.

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RECOMMENDATION:

Recommendation to authorize the City Attorney to submit Stipulations with Request for Award for approval by the Workers' Compensation Appeals Board, and if so approved, authority to pay (1) \$127,075.00 for Stipulations with Request for Award and also (2) to pay \$92.77 per week for a Life Pension thereafter, in compliance with the Appeals Board Order for James Jones.

DISCUSSION:

James Jones has made a claim for injuries allegedly sustained in the course of his employment with the City of Long Beach. The Economic Development and Finance Committee on September 1, 2009, approved the submission to the Workers' Compensation Appeals Board of Stipulations with Request for Award by the City and James Jones, based upon (1) an 84 percent disability rating and (2) a further provision for a Life Pension at the rate of \$92.77 per week after the permanent disability has been fully paid. Finally, there would be a provision for lifetime medical care as may be necessary.


DISCUSSION:

Michael Kinnee has made a claim for injuries allegedly sustained in the course of his employment with the City of Long Beach. The Economic Development and Finance Committee on September 1, 2009 approved the submission to the Workers' Compensation Appeals Board of two Stipulations with Request for Award by the City and Michael Kinnee, based upon a 1) a 9 percent disability rating with provision for lifetime medical care as may be necessary, and 2) an 81 percent disability rating with a further provision for a life pension at the rate of \$162.34 per week after the permanent disability has been paid with provision for lifetime medical care as may be necessary.
