#### RECOMMENDATION:

Authorize the City Manager to execute all necessary documents to receive and expend funding from the Solving Cold Cases with DNA 08 project cooperative agreement, and increase appropriations in the General Grants Fund (SR) and in the Police Department (PD) by \$319,596. (Citywide)

### **DISCUSSION**

The Long Beach Police Department was recently awarded funding in the form of a cooperative agreement from the U. S. Department of Justice, Office of Justice Programs, National Institute of Justice for the Long Beach Solving Cold Cases with DNA 08 project in the amount of \$319,596. The project will be managed as a grant, and funds will be used to reestablish the cold case unit on an overtime basis and to hire two retired homicide investigators, for one full-time equivalent position, to expand the unit's ability to review and prioritize unsolved case evidence for DNA testing. The project period is January 1, 2009 through June 30, 2010.

This item was reviewed by Deputy City Attorney Gary Anderson on October 7, 2008 and Budget Management Officer Victoria Bell on October 8, 2008.
