A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LONG BEACH AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO EXECUTE AN AGREEMENT WITH QUINN **COMPANY** TO **PURCHASE** Α 375-KILOWATT EMERGENCY GENERATOR AND TRAILER, THROUGH CATERPILLAR CORPORATION'S CONTRACT WITH SOURCEWELL (FORMERLY THE NATIONAL JOINT POWER ALLIANCE) IN A TOTAL AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED \$289,983

WHEREAS, the Charter of the City of Long Beach (the "City"), Section 1802, permits the City to purchase services, supplies, materials, equipment and labor with other government agencies by purchasing under their contracts on a voluntary and selective basis when authorized by resolution; and

WHEREAS, the City desires to purchase a 375-kilowatt emergency generator and trailer; and

WHEREAS, Sourcewell has a contract for the purchase of a 375-kilowatt emergency generator and trailer, Contract No. 120617-CAT ("Sourcewell Contract"); and

WHEREAS, the City's participation in the Sourcewell Contract will facilitate the City's ability to purchase as well as provide considerable cost benefits to the City; and

WHEREAS, if the City had to utilize a formal bid process rather than participate in the Sourcewell Contract, considerably more funds would be required;

NOW, THEREFORE, the City Council of the City of Long Beach resolves as follows:

Section 1. The above recitals are true and correct and are incorporated herein by this reference.

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	Section	on 2. The City Man	nager or designee is hereby authorized to enter an
agreement with Quinn Company to purchase a 375-kilowatt emergency generator and			
trailer, of the same type and kind identified in the Sourcewell Contract except as modified			
by mutual agreement of the City and Quinn Company, and the purchase by the City shall			
be on the same terms and conditions afforded to the Sourcewell in an amount not to exceed			
Two Hundred Eighty-Nine Thousand Nine Hundred Eighty-Three Dollars (\$289,983)			
including tax and shipping.			
Section 3. This resolution shall take effect immediately upon its adoption			
by the City Council, and the City Clerk shall certify the vote adopting this resolution.
