### RESOLUTION NO. RES-22-0053

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LONG BEACH AMENDING THE MASTER FEE AND CHARGES SCHEDULE TO ADD MODIFIED SUMMER DAY CAMP PROGRAMMING FEES

WHEREAS, the Department of Parks, Recreation and Marine ("PRM") offered both free and fee-based summer camp options for youth in the summer, prior to the COVID-19 pandemic; and

WHEREAS, a Modified Summer Camp Programming Fee was approved by the Parks and Recreation Commission on June 18, 2020 in response to the economic crisis brought on by the COVID-19 pandemic in order to ensure low cost options for Long Beach families to participate in recreational activities for youth; and

WHEREAS, PRM desires to implement a fee range for Modified Summer Camp Programming Fees, which allows for a flexibility to increase day camp fees as day camp programming transitions to pre-pandemic conditions, and also allows for fee reductions in the event there is another event that triggers the need to drastically reduce the fees.

NOW, THEREFORE, the City Council of the City of Long Beach resolves as follows:

Section 1. The facts set forth in the Recitals of this Resolution are true and correct and are hereby incorporated by reference herein as though set forth in full.

Section 2. The City Council finds that the two additional Modified Summer Camp Programming Fees contained in Exhibit "A" attached hereto and incorporated herein by reference, provide for the charging of reasonable Modified Summer Camp Programming Fees.

Section 3. The City Council hereby adopts and approves the new fees and

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charges as set forth and described in Exhibit "A", attached hereto and incorporated herein by this reference. The fees and charges set forth in Exhibit "A" shall thereafter be incorporated into those fees and charges previously adopted and approved by the City Council by Resolution and shall collectively be known as the Master Fee and Charges Schedule of the City of Long Beach.

Adoption of the new fees and charges set forth and described Section 4. in this Resolution for the specified City programming, shown in Exhibit "A" attached hereto and incorporated herein by reference, are intended to recover costs necessary to provide the programming within the City for which the fees are charged. In adopting the new fees and charges set forth in this Resolution, the City Council of the City of Long Beach is exercising its powers and duties under Article XI, Section 7 of the City Council of the California Constitution.

Section 5. All requirements of California Government Code Sections 66000, et seq., are hereby found to have been satisfied.

Section 6. The fees and charges adopted and all portions of this Resolution are severable. Should any of the fees or charges or any portion of this Resolution be adjudged to be invalid and unenforceable by a body of competent jurisdiction, then the remaining fees and/or Resolution portions shall be, and continue to be, in full force and effect, except as to those fees and/or Resolution portions that have been adjudged invalid. The City Council of the City of Long Beach hereby declares that it would be adopted each of the fees or charges and this Resolution and each section, subsection, clause, sentence, phrase and other portion thereof, irrespective of the fact that one or more of the service fees, charges or sections, subsection, clauses, sentences, phrases or other portions of this Resolution may be held invalid or unconstitutional.

Section 7. All provisions of prior City Council ordinances and resolutions establishing Modified Summer Camp Programming fees are hereby rescinded and repealed in part or in whole to the extent of any conflict between said ordinances and resolutions and the provisions established by this Resolution.

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Section 8. This Resolution shall take effect immediately upon its adoption
