On October 21, 2008, the City Council conducted a hearing to receive supporting documentation into the record in order to grant a permit for entertainment with dancing to Lucky Luke Inc., dba the CopaCabana restaurant located at 2688 South Street. At the conclusion of the hearing, a motion was unintentionally made to approve the recommendation and grant a one-year short-term permit with conditions, as opposed to the intended long-term permit with conditions.

I would like to request the Council to correct this action by rescinding the action taken on October 21, 2008, and approve the permit with conditions for entertainment with dancing.

Recommended Action:

- 1) **Rescind the City Council action taken October 21, 2008 to approve a one-year short-term entertainment permit with conditions to Lucky Luke, Inc., dba the CopaCabana, at 2688 South Street;**
- 2) **Adopt a motion to approve a permit with conditions for entertainment with dancing by patrons at a restaurant to Lucky Luke, Inc., dba the CopaCabana, at 2688 South Street.**

RECOMMENDATION:

Receive the supporting documentation into the record, conclude the hearing and grant the permit, with or without conditions, grant a one year short-term permit, with or without conditions, or deny the permit on the application of Lucky Luke Inc., DBA The Copacabana, 2688 South Street, for Entertainment With Dancing by Patrons at an existing Restaurant. (District 8)

DISCUSSION

The Long Beach Municipal Code (LBMC) requires an application be filed and a hearing be held before the City Council whenever this type of activity is requested and before an entertainment permit is granted or denied.

The LBMC also requires that the City Council make a determination that the application is complete and truthful; the applicant, the person interested in the ownership and operation of the entity, and the officers and trustees of the entity are law-abiding persons who will operate and conduct the business activity in a lawful manner; and, that the public peace, welfare, and safety will not be impaired. If this is so, the application shall be approved, a short-term permit shall be approved, or the application shall be denied.

Attached for your review is the application from Lucky Luke Inc., DBA The Copacabana. Also attached are reports from various departments and a summary of those reports, as well as the license history of the establishment.

City departments have conducted their investigation in accordance with the LBMC. The following summarizes their findings:

- The Police Department recommends that the permit for entertainment with dancing by patrons be approved subject to conditions.
- The Fire Department recommends that the permit for entertainment with dancing by patrons be approved.

- The Health and Human Services Department finds that the building/location meets department requirements for the proposed use with the condition that the establishment remain in compliance with the Long Beach Noise Ordinance (LBMC Chapter 8.80).
- The Long Beach Development Services Department recommends that the permit for entertainment with dancing by patrons be approved.

In the event that any of the recommended conditions attached to any permit or licenses are in conflict, the permittee shall adhere to the strictest of the applicable conditions. This location has been licensed as a restaurant with alcohol since March 2001.

This matter was reviewed by Deputy City Attorney Cristyl Meyers on September 22, 2008.

TIMING CONSIDERATIONS

The hearing date of October 21, 2008, has been posted on the business location, with the applicant and property owners within 300 feet notified by mail.

FISCAL IMPACT

The following fees were collected with the application: Building Review \$20 and Zoning Review \$14 (Long Beach Development Services Department), Police Investigation \$1,000 (Police Department), Labels \$90 (Financial Management Department), and Health/Noise Control \$94 (Health and Human Services Department).

The following fees will be collected if the application is approved: Business License \$325.85 and Regulatory \$825 (Financial Management Department).

In response to your request for a recommendation regarding the above named permit application for Entertainment with Dancing, the Police Department recommends **approval**, subject to the following fifteen (15) conditions of operation:

The Copacabana is a bar/night club located on the southwest corner of South Street and Paramount Avenue, and has been open for business since 2006. The Vice Detail believes the owners of the business have made vast improvements over the past two years. The Vice Investigations Section and North Division Patrol Commander Billy Quach believe the approval of their Entertainment with Dancing Permit would not have an adverse impact on Patrol resources.

CONDITIONS OF OPERATION

- 1) The operation of the establishment shall be limited to those activities and elements expressly indicated on the permit application and approved by the City Council. Any change in the operation, which exceeds the conditions of the approved permit, will require that a new permit application be submitted to the City Council for their review and approval.
- 2) Unless separately applied for, reviewed, and approved, no adult entertainment, as defined by section 5.72.115(B) LBMC shall be conducted on the permitted premises.
- 3) Due to the proximity of neighboring businesses and residences, all door(s) and windows shall be kept closed at all times during any musical entertainment, except in cases of emergency and to permit deliveries. Said door(s) is not to consist solely of a screen or ventilated security door. **Sound shall not be audible within fifty feet (50') from the exterior of the premises in any direction.**
- 4) The permittee shall take reasonable measures to prohibit and prevent the loitering of persons immediately outside any of the entrance/exit doors and the parking lot, at all times, while open for business. This should be done by use of security guards and signage indicating, words to the effect of, "Please respect our neighbors."
- 5) At the conclusion of each event, the permittee shall take reasonable measures to ensure that exiting patrons walk directly to their vehicles, and not loiter in the parking lot or the immediate area.

- 6) The permittee shall not allow employees to discard trash or beer bottles into the outside dumpster between the hours of 10 p.m. and 7 a.m.
- 7) Interior lighting shall be sufficient to make easily discernible the appearance and conduct of all persons and patrons inside the business.
- 8) During any entertainment activity listed on page #7 of the application, the permittee shall be responsible for maintaining an adequate security staff to supervise patrons inside the establishment and the parking lot. For crowds up to fifty (50) people, the permittee shall provide a minimum of one (1) security guard. For crowds over (50) fifty people, the permittee shall provide a minimum of one (1) additional security guard per fifty (50) people. Security guards must be identifiable as "Copacabana employees." Should the permittee's operations give rise to a substantial increase in complaints/calls for service, or trash left in the parking lot, the permittee shall increase staff, or employee uniformed licensed security guards, as directed by the Chief of Police.
- 9) In addition to the above security requirements, the permittee shall staff one (1) security guard in the parking lot between the hours of 10 p.m. and ½ hour after closing. The security guard shall ensure that patrons do not loiter in the parking lot or the immediate area. They shall also ensure the patrons enter and leave the parking lot in a peaceful manner as not to disturb any neighboring businesses or residents who live nearby. The Chief of Police may increase or relax this condition, based on calls-for-service related to problems in the parking lot.
- 10) Current occupancy loads shall be posted at all times, and the permittee shall have an effective system to keep count of the number of occupants present at any given time and provide that information to public safety personnel upon request. (LBMC section 18.48.320)
- 11) The permittee agrees to reimburse the City whenever excessive police services, as determined by the Chief of Police, are required as the result of any incident or nuisance arising out of or in connection with the permittee's operations.
- 12) Copacabana, its promoters, or agents, shall not distribute any advertising matter such as signs, posters, or promotional cards, in or upon any public property, or in or on any vehicle in any such place in the City. Distribution of any advertising matter upon private property shall adhere to the following guidelines: By placing the same matter in a receptacle, clip, or other device designed or intended to receive advertising matter. The permittee shall keep all promoter contracts, including names, addresses and phone numbers, on file at all times, and must be available for inspection anytime.

Thanks for sending us a copy of the Public Notice on the Public Hearing on October 21, 2008 concerning the issuance of a permit for Entertainment with Dancing by Patrons to Lucky Luke Inc., DBA The Copacabana, at 2688 South St., Long Beach, Ca 90805.

I wish I can attend the hearing to voice my objection to the issuance of the permit but my work schedule precludes me from attending. The reason for my objection is that the place is so close to the residential apartments and that the noise and the traffic will cause too much hardship to the people living around it. As of now, my tenants are already complaining about the limited street parking at night, and the "noise" from the "sports bar" The Ajas at 2706 E South St, Long Beach just across from the Copacabana. In addition, they said there were frequent fights and shootings between "drunken" patrons.

Therefore any issuance of an Entertainment Permit to Copacabana will bring in more patrons thus compounding the current hardship to the people living in the area.

I beg that the City deny them the permit.
