

RESOLUTION NO. RES-23-0092

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LONG BEACH AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO EXECUTE AN AGREEMENT WITH ENTERPRISE FM TRUST, DBA ENTERPRISE FLEET MANAGEMENT, INC., TO LEASE VEHICLES FOR VARIOUS POLICE OPERATIONS, THROUGH THEIR CONTRACT WITH SOURCEWELL, IN AN ANNUAL AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED \$170,000 PLUS A 10% CONTIGENCY, FOR A TOTAL ANNUAL CONTRACT AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED \$187,000, FOR A PERIOD OF THREE YEARS, WITH THE OPTION TO RENEW FOR ONE ADDITIONAL ONE-YEAR PERIOD, AT THE DISCRETION OF THE CITY MANAGER

WHEREAS, the Charter of the City of Long Beach (the "City"), Section 1802, permits the City to purchase services, supplies, materials, equipment and labor with other government agencies by purchasing under their contracts on a voluntary and selective basis when authorized by resolution; and

WHEREAS, the City desires to lease vehicles for various Police operations ("Vehicles"); and

WHEREAS, Sourcewell is a State of Minnesota local government agency and service cooperative created under the laws of the State of Minnesota (Minnesota Statutes Section 123A.21) that offers cooperative procurement solutions to its members; and

WHEREAS, the City maintains a wide variety of vehicles to support specialized operations in the Police Department; and

1           WHEREAS, standard replacement cycles are 5 years for these vehicles.  
2 However, they are nearing 6 years old with excessive mileage and have exceeded their  
3 efficient and useful life; and

4           WHEREAS, to avoid costly repairs to these older units, leasing a range of  
5 newer model vehicles provides increased fuel efficiency, lower maintenance costs, and  
6 greater reliability for specialized Police operations; and

7           WHEREAS, the lease contract allows for vehicles to be selectively turned in  
8 and exchanged for another when that flexibility is required; and

9           WHEREAS, Sourcewell has a contract for the lease of these Vehicles,  
10 Contract No. 030122-EFM ("Sourcewell Contract"); and

11           WHEREAS, the City's participation in the Sourcewell Contract will facilitate  
12 acquisition of these Vehicles as well as provide considerable cost benefits to the City; and

13           WHEREAS, if the City had to utilize a formal bid process rather than  
14 participate in the Sourcewell Contract considerably more funds would be required;

15           NOW, THEREFORE, the City Council of the City of Long Beach resolves as  
16 follows:

17           Section 1.    The above recitals are true and correct and are incorporated  
18 herein by this reference.

19           Section 2.    The City Manager or designee is hereby authorized to enter an  
20 agreement with Enterprise FM Trust, dba Enterprise Fleet Management, Inc., to lease  
21 Vehicles, of the same type and kind identified in the Sourcewell Contract except as  
22 modified by mutual agreement of the City and Enterprise FM Trust, dba Enterprise Fleet  
23 Management, Inc., and the lease by the City shall be on the same terms and conditions  
24 afforded to Sourcewell, in an annual amount of One Hundred Seventy Thousand  
25 (\$170,000), plus a ten percent (10%) contingency of Seventeen Thousand Dollars  
26 (\$17,000), for a total annual contract amount not to exceed One Hundred Eighty Seven  
27 Thousand (\$187,000), for a period of three (3) years with the option to renew for one (1)  
28 additional one-year period, at the discretion of the City Manager.
