3 A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE  
4 CITY OF LONG BEACH CONFIRMING, FOLLOWING  
5 HEARING, THE ANNUAL REPORT OF THE BELMONT  
6 SHORE PARKING AND BUSINESS IMPROVEMENT AREA  
7 ADVISORY COMMISSION, CONTINUING THE LEVY OF  
8 ANNUAL ASSESSMENT AS SET FORTH IN SAID REPORT  
9 AND SETTING FORTH OTHER RELATED MATTERS

11 WHEREAS, pursuant to Section 36533 of the California Streets and  
12 Highways Code, the Belmont Shore Parking and Business Improvement Area Advisory  
13 Commission has caused a Report to be prepared for Fiscal Year 2017-2018 relating to  
14 the Belmont Shore Parking and Business Improvement Area which is located along the  
15 commercial corridor of Second Street generally between Livingston Drive and Bayshore  
16 Avenue within the City of Long Beach; and

17 WHEREAS, said Report contains, among other things, all matters required  
18 to be included by the above-cited Section 36533; and

19 WHEREAS, on September 19, 2017 at 5:00 p.m., the City Council  
20 conducted a public hearing relating to that Report in accordance with its Resolution of  
21 Intention No. RES-17-0071, adopted August 8, 2017 at which public hearing all interested  
22 persons were afforded a full opportunity to appear and be heard on all matters relating to  
23 the Report as well as past years' proceedings and assessments; and

24 WHEREAS, a majority protest not having been received, it is the City  
25 Council's desire to confirm the Report as originally filed and continue the levy of the  
26 Annual Assessment as described in the Report;

27 NOW THEREFORE, the City Council of the City of Long Beach resolves as  
28 follows:
