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ORDINANCE NO. C-7922

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE
CITY OF LONG BEACH AMENDING THE LONG BEACH
MUNICIPAL CODE BY AMENDING SECTION 2.84.010
REGARDING THE AUTHORITY OF THE CITY
PURCHASING AGENT; DECLARING THE URGENCY
THEREOF; AND DECLARING THAT THIS ORDINANCE
SHALL TAKE EFFECT IMMEDIATELY

The City Council of the City of Long Beach ordains as follows:

Section 1. Section 2.84.010 of the Long Beach Municipal Code is
hereby amended to read as follows:

2.84.010 Authority of City Purchasing Agent and other to contract

The City Purchasing Agent, with the written approval of and in
accordance with procedures provided by the City Manager, and such
faithful performance bonds as the City Manager may deem reasonably
necessary, is hereby authorized to bind the City through the issuance of a
purchase order without advertising for bids for the purchase of services,
labor, supplies materials, goods, or other valuable consideration furnished
to the City for amounts not exceeding One Hundred Thousand Dollars
(\$100,000.00) and, if the purchase will be reimbursed by State or Federal
grant funds relating to homeland security, for amounts not exceeding Five
Hundred Thousand Dollars (\$500,000.00).

Other persons categorized as managers in each City department,
with the written approval of and in accordance with procedures provided
by the City Manager or by the Water Commission or Harbor Commission,

1 after recommendation by the head of the department, are hereby
2 authorized to bind the City through the issuance of a purchase order
3 without advertising for bids for the purchase of services, labor, supplies,
4 materials, goods, or other valuable consideration furnished to the City for
5 amounts not exceeding Ten Thousand Dollars (\$10,000.00).

7 Sec. 2. Declaration of Urgency. This ordinance is an emergency
8 measure, and it is urgently required for the reason that the City must complete its
9 purchase of equipment and goods and obtain invoices from the vendors of that
10 equipment and those goods to submit to the federal Office of Domestic Preparedness
11 by the end of May, 2004.

13 Sec. 3. This ordinance is an emergency ordinance duly adopted by the
14 City Council by a vote of five of its members and shall take effect immediately. The City
15 Clerk shall certify to a separate roll call and vote on the question of the emergency of
16 this ordinance and to its passage by the vote of five members of the City Council of the
17 City of Long Beach, and cause the same to be posted in three conspicuous places in
18 the City of Long Beach.

19 This ordinance shall also be adopted by the City Council as a regular
20 ordinance, to the end that in the event of any defect or invalidity in connection with the
21 adoption of this ordinance as an emergency ordinance, the same shall, nevertheless,
22 be and become effective on the thirty-first day after it is approved by the Mayor. The
23 City Clerk shall certify to the passage of this ordinance by the City Council of the City of
24 Long Beach and shall cause the same to be posted in three conspicuous places in the
25 City of Long Beach.

26 I hereby certify that on a separate roll call and vote which was taken by

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


