3 A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE
4 CITY OF LONG BEACH AUTHORIZING THE CITY
5 MANAGER TO EXECUTE A MASTER SERVICES AND
6 SUBSCRIPTION AGREEMENT WITH CHARGEPOINT,
7 INC., WITHOUT ADVERTISING FOR BIDS, IN AN ANNUAL
8 AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED \$7,200 FOR OPERATING 13
9 ELECTRIC VEHICLE CHARGING STATIONS IN CITY-
10 OWNED CITY PLACE PARKING GARAGE C

12 WHEREAS, the Charter of the City of Long Beach, Section 1801, permits
13 the City Manager to enter into a contract on behalf of the City, in writing or otherwise,
14 without advertising for bids, for services, supplies, materials, equipment or labor for
15 actual emergency work when authorized by resolution; and

16 WHEREAS, on February 14, 2017, the City Council approved the City's
17 participation in Southern California Edison's (SCE) Charge Ready Program (Program);
18 and

19 WHEREAS, through the Program, SCE is providing free electric
20 infrastructure required for the installation of new EV charging stations in City-owned City
21 Place Parking Garage C; and

22 WHEREAS, City is responsible for purchasing and installing the EV
23 charging stations; and

24 WHEREAS, the Public Works Department investigated procurement
25 options for EV charging stations and found that ChargePoint, Inc. is the only vendor that
26 could provide charging stations that meet the City of Long Beach Charge Ready Program
27 requirements and can be readily procured within the Program timelines; and

28 WHEREAS, no useful purpose would be served by advertising for bids and

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1 to do so would constitute an idle and useless act and an unnecessary expenditure of
2 public funds because ChargePoint, Inc. is the only corporation, firm or individual that
3 could or would bid to provide charging stations that meet the Program requirements in
4 the City-owned City Place Parking Garage C;

5 NOW, THEREFORE, the City Council of the City of Long Beach resolves as
6 follows:

7 Section 1. The City Manager is hereby authorized to enter into a Master
8 Services and Subscription Agreement with ChargePoint, Inc. without advertising for bids
9 for operating thirteen (13) electric vehicle charging stations in City-owned City Place
10 Parking Garage C, in an annual amount not to exceed Seven Thousand Two Hundred
11 Dollars (\$7,200).


12 Section 2. This resolution shall take effect immediately upon its adoption
13 by the City Council, and the City Clerk shall certify the vote adopting this resolution.
