RECOMMENDATION:

Receive the supporting documentation into the record, conclude the hearing and grant a One-Year Short-Term Permit with conditions on the application of Broadlind Lounge, LLC, DBA The Basement, 149 Linden Ave. #B-100, for Entertainment with Dancing by Patrons. (District 2)

DISCUSSION

The Long Beach Municipal Code (LBMC) requires an application be filed and a hearing be held before the City Council whenever this type of activity is requested and before an entertainment permit is granted or denied.

The LBMC also requires that the City Council make a determination that the permit application is complete and truthful; the applicant and the officers and trustees of the entity are law-abiding persons who will operate and conduct the business activity in a lawful manner; and that public peace, welfare and safety will not be impaired. If this is so, the application shall be approved, a short-term entertainment permit shall be approved, or the application shall be denied.

The City Council has the authority to approve the following options: 1) grant the Permit, with or without conditions; or 2) grant a One-Year Short-Term Entertainment Permit, with or without conditions; or, 3) deny the Permit on the application.

City departments have conducted their investigations in accordance with the LBMC. Attached for your review are the departmental investigative reports, the business ownership and permit history, and the entertainment permit application.

The following summarizes departmental findings:

- The Police Department recommends that the permit for entertainment with dancing by patrons be approved as a One-Year Short-Term Permit subject to recommended conditions.
- The Fire Department finds that the building/location meets department requirements for the proposed use.

- The Health and Human Services Department finds that the building/location meets department requirements for the proposed use with the condition that the establishment remain in compliance with the Long Beach Noise Ordinance (LBMC Chapter 8.80).
- The Development Services Department finds that the building/location meets department requirements for the proposed use.

The Department of Financial Management, Business Relations Bureau, has reviewed all submitted department documents and correspondence and, after a thorough investigative process, recommends that the permit for entertainment with dancing by patrons be approved as a One-Year Short-Term Entertainment Permit subject to the conditions (attached).

In the event that any of the recommended conditions are in conflict with other permits or licenses, the permittee shall adhere to the strictest of the applicable conditions. This location has been licensed as a bar/tavern/lounge since November of 2011.

This matter was reviewed by Deputy City Attorney Amy R. Webber on May 17, 2012.

TIMING CONSIDERATIONS

The hearing date of June 12, 2012, has been posted on the business location, with the applicant and property owners within 300 feet notified by mail.

FISCAL IMPACT

The following fees were collected with the application: Building Review \$20 and Zoning Review \$15 (Development Services), Police Investigation \$1,183 (Police Department), and Labels \$90 (Financial Management Department).

The following fees will be collected if the application is approved: Business License \$321.97 and Regulatory \$1,006 (Financial Management Department).

Recommended Conditions of Operation Broadlind Lounge, LLC, DBA The Basement 149 Linden Avenue #B-100 Application for Entertainment With Dancing

In regards to the above named permit application for Entertainment With Dancing, the Department of Financial Management recommends approval subject to the following conditions:

CONDITIONS OF OPERATION

- 1. The operation of the establishment shall be limited to those activities and elements expressly indicated on the permit application and approved by the City Council. Any change in the operation, which exceeds the conditions of the approved permit, will require that a new permit application be submitted to the City Council for their review and approval.
- 2. Unless separately applied for, reviewed, and approved, no adult entertainment, as defined by section 21.15.110 LBMC shall be conducted on the permitted premises.
- 3. Entertainment activities indicated on page #7 of your entertainment application shall be restricted to no later than 11:00 P.M. Sunday through Wednesday and 1:00 A.M. Thursday through Saturday. Outdoor entertainment is prohibited.
- 4. There shall be no "queue" allowed after 10:00 P.M. Sunday through Wednesday and 11:00 P.M. Thursday through Saturday. All persons gathering outside after the allowed hours shall be considered to be loitering. Queue is defined as persons awaiting entry after the business is at capacity.
- 5. No owner, operator, or manager shall permit any person under the age of twenty-one (21) years within the premises, at any time, during the hours of operation.
- 6. The establishment shall remain in compliance with all applicable sections of the Long Beach Noise Ordinance (LMBC Chapter 8.80).
- 7. Due to the proximity of neighboring businesses and residences, all door(s) and windows shall be kept closed at all times during any musical entertainment, except in cases of emergency and to permit deliveries. Said door(s) is not to consist solely of a screen or ventilated security door. Sound shall not be audible beyond fifty feet (50') from the exterior of the premises in any direction.
- 8. The permittee shall not allow employees to discard trash or beer bottles into the outside dumpster between the hours of 10:00 P.M. and 7:00 A.M.

9. The permittee shall provide a minimum of one (1) uniformed security guard during all times that the entertainment activities are being conducted for crowds up to fifty (50) people. For crowds over fifty (50) people, the permittee shall provide a minimum of one (1) additional uniformed security guard per fifty (50) people. Patrons awaiting entry in a defined queue shall be counted toward the calculation of required security staffing levels.

The attire of each security guard shall clearly indicate the guard's affiliation with the establishment by means of a pin, shirt, or other visible form of identification. Should the permittee's operations give rise to a substantial increase in complaint/calls for police service, or trash left in the parking lot, the permittee shall increase security staff, implement the use of electronic metal detection equipment, increase outside lighting, or make other changes to the premises or operation as the Chief of Police determines are necessary to protect the safety of the public.

- 10. The permittee shall take reasonable measures to prohibit and prevent the loitering of persons immediately outside any of the entrance/exit doors and the parking lot, at all times while open for business. This should be done by use of security guards and signage indicating words to the effect of, "Please respect our neighbors" or something similar.
- 11. At the conclusion of each event, the permittee shall take reasonable measures to ensure that exiting patrons walk directly to their vehicles, and not loiter in the parking lot or the immediate area.
- 12. The permittee agrees to reimburse the City whenever excessive police services, as determined by the Chief of Police, are required as the result of any incident or nuisance arising out of or in connection with the permittee's operations.
- 13. The permittee shall install and maintain a video surveillance system that monitors no less than the front and rear of the business with full view of the public right-of-ways and any parking lot under the control of the permittee. The video system must be capable of delineating on playback the activity and physical features of persona and areas within the premises. Recordings shall be retained for a minimum of 30 days and be accessible via the Internet by the Long Beach Police Department. A Public Internet Protocol (IP) address and user name/password is also required to allow the Long Beach Police Department to view live and recorded video from these cameras over the internet. All video security cameras shall be installed to the satisfaction of the Chief of Police, Director of Technology Services, and Director of Development Services. At the discretion of the Chief of Police, the permittee may be required to add additional video cameras.
- 14. Current occupancy loads shall be posted at all times, and the permittee shall have an effective system to keep count of the number of occupants present at any given time and provide that information to public safety personnel upon request.

- 15. Any graffiti painted or marked upon the premises, or on any adjacent area under the control of the licensee, shall be removed or painted over within 24 hours of being applied.
- 16. All promoters must have or obtain a City of Long Beach business License <u>prior to</u> conducting entertainment activities governed by this permit. The permittee shall be responsible for all entertainment activities at the location, including those conducted by promoters.
- 17. The permittee must provide all promoters, independent contractors, and performers, hired to conduct entertainment activities with a copy of the approved permit, which shall include a copy of the approved conditions of operation.
- 18. The business, its promoters, or agents, shall not distribute any advertising matter such as signs, posters, or promotional cards, in or upon any public property, or in or on any vehicle in any such place in the City. Distribution of any advertising matter upon private property shall adhere to the following guidelines: By placing the same matter in a receptacle, clip, or other device designed or intended to receive advertising matter. The permittee shall keep all agent and promoter's contracts, including names, addresses and phone numbers, on file at all times, and must be available for inspection at anytime.
- 19. The permittee shall not block the public streets or cone off any public parking spaces without first obtaining a permit from the office of City Special Events and Filming.
- 20. The permittee shall encourage patrons to utilize public parking lots rather than neighborhood parking spaces. This should be done by utilizing security guards, signage, and/or advertising.
- 21. The permittee shall maintain full compliance with all applicable laws, ABC laws, ordinances and stated conditions. In the event of a conflict with the requirements of this permit, the more stringent regulation shall apply.
- 22. The permittee must submit an application for the renewal of the entertainment with dancing permit no later than February 12, 2013 or four (4) months prior to the One-Year Short-Term Permit expiration date to continue to provide entertainment without a break.
- 23. The permittee, shall, within ninety (90) days of an approved entertainment permit, submit proof of attending the LEAD program offered by the Department of Alcoholic Beverage Control. In the event that the LEAD program class is not offered within this ninety day period, the permittee shall attend the next available class. Proof of completion shall be submitted to the Long Beach Police Department Vice Investigations Section.





In response to your request for a recommendation regarding the above named permit application for Entertainment With Dancing, the Police Department recommends **approval** of a **One-Year Short-Term Entertainment With Dancing Permit**, subject to the following twenty-one (21) conditions:

The Basement is a bar located in the basement of the Broadlind Hotel, which is located on the southwest corner of Broadway and Linden Avenue. The corporation is owned by Jim Najah and currently holds a Type 48 (On Sale General Public Premise) Alcoholic Beverage Control license. The business has been in operation since 2005, and had a valid entertainment permit. Because the business no longer provides a food menu, they were required to exchange their ABC license for a Type 48 (On Sale General Public Premise) Alcoholic Beverage Control license. The change also required them to apply for a new entertainment permit. On October 26, 2011, the Police Department received a request to review a new application for an Entertainment with Dancing Permit requesting live amplified music, a disc jockey, and karaoke music.

Based upon the Vice Section's investigation and the South Division Patrol Commander's recommendation, the Long Beach Police Department has determined the public peace, safety, and welfare would not be adversely impacted by the issuance of this permit provided the appropriate conditions are imposed and observed by the applicant. Due to the number of calls-for-service and arrests determined to be attributable to the business, the Police Department recommends a One-Year Short-Term Entertainment with Dancing Permit would be in the best interests of the surrounding community and the City of Long Beach.

CONDITIONS OF OPERATION

- The operation of the establishment shall be limited to those activities and elements expressly indicated on the permit application and approved by the City Council. Any change in the operation, which exceeds the conditions of the approved permit, will require that a new permit application be submitted to the City Council for their review and approval.
- 2) Unless separately applied for, reviewed, and approved, no adult entertainment, as defined by section 5.72.115(B) LBMC, shall be conducted on the permitted premises.

- 3) Entertainment activities indicated on page #7 of your entertainment application shall be restricted to 11:00 p.m. Sunday thru Wednesday, and until 1:00 a.m., Thursday thru Saturday nights.
- 4) No owner, operator, or manager shall permit any person under the age of twenty-one (21) years within the premises at any time during the hours of operation.
- Due to the proximity of neighboring businesses and residences, all door(s) and windows shall be kept closed at all times during any musical entertainment, except in cases of emergency, and to permit deliveries. Said door(s) is not to consist solely of a screen or ventilated security door. Sound shall not be audible within fifty feet (50') from the exterior of the premises in any direction.
- The Basement, or its agents, shall not distribute any advertising matter such as signs, posters, or promotional cards, in or upon any public property, any vehicle, or in any other such place in the City of Long Beach. Distribution of any advertising matter upon private property shall adhere to the following guidelines: By placing the same matter in a receptacle, clip, or other device designed or intended to receive advertising matter. The permittee shall keep all agent contracts, including names, addresses, and phone numbers, on file at all times, and be available for inspection at any time.
- 7) The permittee shall provide a minimum of one (1) uniformed security guard during all times that the entertainment activities are being conducted for crowds up to fifty people. For crowds over fifty people, the permittee shall provide a minimum of one (1) additional uniformed security guard per fifty (50) people. Patrons awaiting entry in a defined queue shall be counted toward the calculation of required security staffing levels.
 - Security guards must be identifiable as The Basement employees. Should the permittee's operations give rise to a substantial increase in complaints/calls for police service, the permittee may be required to increase security staff, implement the use of electronic metal detection equipment, increase outside lighting, or make other changes to the premises or operation, as the Chief of Police determines are necessary.
- There shall be no "queue" allowed after 10 p.m. Sunday thru Wednesday nights, and 11 p.m. Thursday thru Saturday nights. All persons gathering outside after the allowed hours shall be considered to be loitering. Queue is defined as persons awaiting entry after the business is at capacity
- 9) The Permittee shall not block the public street, or cone off any public parking spaces without first obtaining a permit from the office of City Special Events and Filming.

- 10) The Permittee shall encourage patrons to utilize public parking lots rather than neighborhood parking spaces. This should be done by utilizing security guards, signage, and/or advertising.
- 11) The permittee shall take reasonable measures to prohibit and prevent the loitering of persons immediately outside any of the entrance/exit doors and the parking lot, at all times, while open for business. This should be done by utilizing security guards and signage with verbiage such as, "Please respect our neighbors," or something similar.
- 12) At the conclusion of each event, the permittee shall take reasonable measures to ensure that exiting patrons walk directly to their vehicles and not loiter in the parking lot or the immediate area.
- 13) Current occupancy loads shall be posted at all times, and the permittee shall have an effective system to keep count of the number of occupants present at any given time. This information shall be provided to public safety personnel upon request.
- 14) The permittee agrees to reimburse the City of Long Beach whenever excessive police services, as determined by the Chief of Police, are required as the result of any incident, or nuisance arising out of, or in connection with the permittee's operations.
- The permittee shall not allow employees to discard trash or beer bottles into the outside dumpster between the hours of 10 p.m. and 7 a.m.
- All independent contractors must have or obtain a City of Long Beach Business License prior to conducting entertainment activities governed by this permit. The permittee shall be responsible for all entertainment activities at the location, including those conducted by promoters or independent contractors.
- 17) The permittee must provide all promoters, independent contractors, and dancers, hired to conduct entertainment activities with a copy of the approved permit, which shall include a copy of the approved conditions of operation.
- 18) The permittee shall maintain full compliance with all applicable laws, ABC laws, ordinances, and stated conditions. In the event of a conflict between the requirements of this permit, your conditional use permit, or your Alcoholic Beverage Control license, the more stringent regulation shall apply.
- Any graffiti painted or marked upon the premises, or on any adjacent area under the control of the permittee shall be removed or painted over within 24 hours of being applied.

- The permittee shall be responsible for installing and maintaining a video surveillance system that monitors no less than the front and rear of the business, with full view of the public right-of-ways, and any parking lot under the control of the permittee. These cameras shall record video for a minimum of 30 days and be accessible via the Internet by the Long Beach Police Department. A Public Internet Protocol (IP) address and user name/password is also required to allow the Long Beach Police Department to view live and recorded video from these cameras over the internet. All video security cameras shall be installed to the satisfaction of the Chief of Police, Director of Technology Services, and Director of Development Services. At the discretion of the Chief of Police, the permittee may be required to add additional video cameras.
- The permittee, shall, within ninety (90) days of an approved entertainment permit, submit proof of attending the LEAD program offered by the Department of Alcoholic Beverage Control. In the event that the LEAD program class is not offered within this ninety day period, the permittee shall attend the next available class. Proof of completion shall be submitted to the Long Beach Police Department's Vice Investigations Section.
