WHEREAS, the Charter of the City of Long Beach (the "City"), Section 1802, permits the City to purchase services, supplies, materials, equipment and labor with other government agencies by purchasing under their contracts on a voluntary and selective basis when authorized by resolution; and

WHEREAS, the City desires to purchase three (3) John Deere 7630 tractors from Deere & Company dba John Deere Company; and

WHEREAS, the State of California Multiple Award Schedule (CMAS) has a contract for the purchase of John Deere 7630 tractors under Contract No. 4-07-23-0007C ("State Contract"); and

WHEREAS, the City's participation in the State Contract will facilitate acquisition of these tractors as well as provide considerable cost benefits to the City; and

WHEREAS, if the City had to go to formal bid rather than participate in the State Contract considerably more funds would be required;

NOW, THEREFORE, the City Council of the City of Long Beach resolves as follows:

Section 1. The above recitals are true and correct and are incorporated herein by this reference.

Section 2. The City Manager of the City of Long Beach is hereby

authorized to enter an agreement with Deere & Company dba John Deere Company in an amount not to exceed \$278,695.29, including tax, to purchase three (3) John Deere 7630 tractors of the same type and kind identified in the State Contract, except as modified by mutual agreement of the City and Deere & Company dba John Deere Company, and the purchase by the City shall be on the same terms and conditions This resolution shall take effect immediately upon its adoption by the City Council, and the City Clerk shall certify the vote adopting this resolution.
