HONORABLE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL City of Long Beach California

RECOMMENDATION:

Adopt a Resolution authorizing the City Manager, or designee, to execute a contract with Zonar Systems, Inc., of Seattle, WA, for the purchase of Zonar electronic vehicle inspection and tracking hardware and monitoring services, in an annual amount not to exceed \$250,000, for a period of two years, with the option to renew for two additional one-year periods, at the discretion of the City Manager. (Citywide)

DISCUSSION

City Council approval is requested to enter into a contract with Zonar Systems, Inc., for the purchase of vehicle inspection and tracking components as well as monthly monitoring service, for 583 active units in the City's fleet. The City has had the Zonar system in continuous operation in City vehicles since October 2013. The current contract ends July 21, 2017. Tracking and inspection software is effective for efficient route/trip planning, identifying vehicle location, vehicle idling policy enforcement, and vehicle utilization studies.

The Financial Management Department, Fleet Services Bureau, is responsible for maintaining the Zonar equipment and paying the annual monitoring service charges. Zonar Systems, Inc., is the original equipment manufacturer and sole source provider in the United States. Therefore, no useful purpose would be served by advertising for bids and to do so would constitute an unnecessary expenditure of public funds.

City Charter Section 1801 requires that contracts for City purchases be awarded to the lowest responsible bidder after a competitive bid process, but allows for awards without a competitive bid process if accompanied by a Resolution adopted by the City Council.

This matter was reviewed by Deputy City Attorney Monica J. Kilaita on May 4, 2017 and by Assistant Finance Director Lea Eriksen on May 2, 2017.

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SUSTAINABILITY

Utilization of GPS tracking and vehicle inspection software may assist City departments in route planning for maximum efficiency. The subsequent reduction in fuel use lowers the City's carbon footprint.

TIMING CONSIDERATIONS

City Council action to adopt a Resolution and execute a contract concurrently is requested on May 23, 2017, to ensure that the new contract is in place expeditiously.

FISCAL IMPACT

The cost of this contract will not exceed \$250,000 annually, and is budgeted in the Fleet Services Fund (IS 386) in the Financial Management Department (FM). Parts and monitoring costs are charged to user departments through work orders completed or special items charges executed during the Fleet monthly billing process. There is no local job impact associated with this recommendation.

SUGGESTED ACTION:

Approve recommendation.

RESOLUTION NO.

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LONG BEACH AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO EXECUTE A CONTRACT WITH ZONAR SYSTEMS, INC., WITHOUT ADVERTISING FOR BIDS, FOR THE PURCHASE OF ZONAR ELECTRONIC VEHICLE **INSPECTION** AND TRACKING HARDWARE AND MONITORING SERVICES FOR A PERIOD OF TWO YEARS, WITH AN OPTION TO RENEW FOR TWO ADDITIONAL ONE-YEAR PERIODS, IN AN ANNUAL AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED \$250,000

WHEREAS, the City currently has 583 active units in the City's fleet in need 14 of Zonar electronic vehicle inspection and tracking components as well as monthly 15 16 monitoring services; and

17 WHEREAS, the Fleet Services Bureau, is responsible for maintaining the Zonar equipment and paying the annual monitoring service charges; and 18

WHEREAS, Zonar Systems, Inc. is the original equipment manufacturer 19 and sole source provider in the United States; and 20

WHEREAS, as a result, no useful purpose would be served by advertising 21 for bids and to do so would constitute an idle and useless act and an unnecessary 22 expenditure of public funds because Zonar Systems, Inc. is the only corporation, firm or 23 individual that could or would bid for the furnishing of these inspection and monitoring 24 25 services and hardware to the City;

NOW, THEREFORE, the City Council of the City of Long Beach resolves as 26 27 follows:

> Section 1. The City Manager is hereby authorized to enter a contract

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with Zonar Systems, Inc. without advertising for bids for the purchase of Zonar electronic 1 vehicle inspection and tracking components as well as monthly monitoring services as 2 3 may be required by the City for a period of two (2) years in an annual amount not to exceed \$250,000, including tax. The parties may, by mutual agreement, extend the term 4 5 for two (2) additional periods of one (1) year each at the same annual amount.

This resolution shall take effect immediately upon its adoption Section 2. by the City Council, and the City Clerk shall certify the vote adopting this resolution.
