

RESOLUTION NO. RES-21-0044

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LONG BEACH AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO EXECUTE AN AGREEMENT WITH SOUTH COAST FIRE EQUIPMENT, INC. TO PURCHASE A PIERCE ARROW XT FIRE LADDER TRUCK, WITH RELATED EQUIPMENT AND ACCESSORIES, THROUGH THEIR CONTRACT WITH HOUSTON-GALVESTON AREA COUNCIL IN AN AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED \$1,565,259, INCLUSIVE OF TAXES AND FEES

WHEREAS, the Charter of the City of Long Beach (the "City"), Section 1802, permits the City to purchase services, supplies, materials, equipment and labor with other government agencies by purchasing under their contracts on a voluntary and selective basis when authorized by resolution; and

WHEREAS, On January 21st, 2020, fire ladder truck # 350 was in a maintenance bay at Fleet Services for routine service. At approximately 2:00 a.m., the shore power component, located under the main cab of the unit, caught fire. The fire alarm system was triggered, and the Fire Department responded and extinguished the fire, but the ladder truck was completely destroyed by that time; and

WHEREAS, the City desires to purchase one (1) Pierce Arrow XT fire ladder truck, with related equipment and accessories ("Fire Ladder Truck") to replace fire ladder truck #350; and

WHEREAS, Houston-Galveston Area Council has a contract with South Coast Fire Equipment, Inc. for the purchase of these Fire Ladder Trucks("H-GAC Contract"); and

WHEREAS, the City's participation in the H-GAC Contract will facilitate the

1 City's ability to purchase as well as provide considerable cost benefits to the City; and

2 WHEREAS, if the City had to utilize a formal bid process rather than
3 participate in the H-GAC Contract considerably more funds would be required;

4 NOW, THEREFORE, the City Council of the City of Long Beach resolves as
5 follows:

6 Section 1. The above recitals are true and correct and are incorporated
7 herein by this reference.

8 Section 2. The City Manager or designee is hereby authorized to enter
9 an agreement with South Coast Fire Equipment, Inc. to purchase one (1) Pierce Arrow
10 XT fire ladder truck, with related equipment and accessories, of the same type and kind
11 identified in the H-GAC Contract except as modified by mutual agreement of the City and
12 South Coast Fire Equipment, Inc., and the purchase by the City shall be on the same
13 terms and conditions afforded to Houston-Galveston Area Council in an amount not to
14 exceed One Million Five Hundred Sixty-Five Thousand Two Hundred Fifty-Nine Dollars
15 (\$1,565,259), inclusive of taxes and fees, extending until the warranty on the Fire Ladder
16 Truck expires.

17 Section 3. This resolution shall take effect immediately upon its adoption
18 by the City Council, and the City Clerk shall certify the vote adopting this resolution.
