3 A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE  
4 CITY OF LONG BEACH RETRACTING IMPLEMENTATION  
5 OF GOVERNMENT CODE SECTION 20636(c)(4)  
6 PURSUANT TO SECTION 20691 AS TO PAYING AND  
7 REPORTING THE VALUE OF EMPLOYER PAID MEMBER  
8 CONTRIBUTIONS FOR EMPLOYEES REPRESENTED BY  
9 THE LONG BEACH CITY PROSECUTORS ASSOCIATION  
10 TO THE CALIFORNIA PUBLIC EMPLOYEES' RETIREMENT  
11 SYSTEM (CalPERS)

13 WHEREAS, the City of Long Beach has the authority to implement  
14 Government Code Section 20636(c)(4) pursuant to Section 20691; and

15 WHEREAS, the City of Long Beach has a written labor policy or agreement  
16 which specifically provides for the normal member contributions to be paid by the  
17 employer, and reported as special compensation; and

18 WHEREAS, the City has engaged in negotiations with the Long Beach City  
19 Prosecutors Association and the parties have agreed to amend the Memorandum of  
20 Understanding with respect to payment and reporting of the value of employer paid  
21 member contributions (EPMC); and

22 WHEREAS, members of the City Prosecutors Association have agreed to  
23 pay the full member contribution; and

24 WHEREAS, one of the steps in the procedures to implement this change is  
25 the adoption by the governing body of the City of Long Beach of a resolution giving notice  
26 of its intention to cease paying and reporting the value of employer paid member  
27 contributions (EPMC) as compensation for all members of the group or class as identified  
28 herein.

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1 NOW, THEREFORE, the City Council of the City of Long Beach resolves as  
2 follows:

3 Section 1. Effective as of November 19, 2011, the governing body of the  
4 City of Long Beach shall retract its previous implementation of Government Code Section  
5 20636(c)(4) pursuant to Section 20691 as to paying and reporting the value of Employer  
6 Paid Member Contributions (EPMC) for miscellaneous employees represented by the  
7 Long Beach City Prosecutors Association. In so doing, the City will pay zero percent  
8 (0%) and report the same percent (0%) and the member will pay one hundred percent  
9 (100%) of the normal member contribution which is currently eight percent (8%) of the  
10 member's compensation.


11 Section 2. This resolution shall take effect immediately upon its adoption  
12 by the City Council, and the City Clerk shall certify the vote adopting this resolution.
