ASSIGNMENT CONSENT AGREEMENT

- **3.** Assignee accepts all of the rights, title, interest and obligations in and to Agreement No. 28025 and agrees and covenants to incur and be responsible for all of the duties and obligations of Assignor thereunder, notwithstanding anything to the contrary in any other agreements between Assignor and Assignee.
- 4. This Assignment shall be binding upon and shall inure to the benefit of the parties and their successors and assigns; however, nothing in this consent shall be interpreted to waive City's right to object to any future transfer or sale of any rights or obligations in this Agreement.
 - 5. This Assignment shall be governed by the laws of the State of California.
 - 6. This Assignment shall be effective upon execution by City.
- 7. This Assignment may be executed in any number of counterparts, and each executed counterpart shall have the same force and effect as an original instrument and shall be construed as if all the parties to the aggregate counterparts had signed the same instrument.
