RECOMMENDATION:

Adopt Resolutions declaring the official results of the City of Long Beach Primary Nominating Election held on March 3, 2020.

DISCUSSION

Attached are the Resolutions prepared by the City Attorney on the results of the consolidated City of Long Beach Primary Nominating Election held on March 3, 2020:

1. A Resolution of the City Council of the City of Long Beach declaring the results of the Primary Nominating Election held in the City of Long Beach, California, on Tuesday, March 3, 2020, for the purpose of nominating and/or electing candidates for three (3) offices on the City Council from district numbers 2, 6, and 8; and nominating and/or electing candidates for the Long Beach Unified School District Governing Board Members for the Second and Fourth Districts; and directing the City Clerk to place on ballots to be used at the General Municipal Election to be held on the 3rd day of November 2020, the names of the candidates declared to have been nominated in the Primary Nominating Election; and directing the City Clerk to issue a certificate of Election to the candidate declared to have been elected at the Primary Nominating Election;
2. A Resolution of the City Council of the City of Long Beach declaring the results of the Special Municipal Election held in the City of Long Beach, California, on Tuesday, March 3, 2020, for the two (2) ballot measures which had been submitted to a vote of the qualified electors of the City;
3. A Resolution ordering, proclaiming, calling, giving notice of and providing for the holding of a General Municipal Election to be held in the City of Long Beach, California, on Tuesday, the 3rd day of November, 2020, for the election of three (3) City Councilmembers from the Second, Sixth, and Eighth Districts and one (1) Long Beach Unified School District Governing Board Member from District 2, for a full term of four (4) years commencing with the third Tuesday of December, 2020; Designating the ballot listing of the candidates to be voted on; and adopting provisions relating to translations of and the charges for costs of candidate statements.

TIMING CONSIDERATIONS

Approval of the recommended action on April 14, 2020, will meet the provisions of Elections Code Sections 10262 and 10263. To complete the certification process, the City Council is required to adopt a Resolution reciting the fact of the election and the statement of the results as provided in section 10264 of the California Elections Code.

This matter was reviewed by Deputy City Attorney Amy Webber on March 10, 2020.

FISCAL IMPACT

Adopting the attached Resolutions will have no fiscal impact.

23 WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Long Beach did, by Resolution
24 No. RES-19-0159, duly call and provide for the holding of a Primary Nominating Election
25 on Tuesday, March 3, 2020, for the purpose of nominating and/or electing candidates for
26 three (3) City Council Offices, namely for the Second, Sixth and Eighth Districts; and

27 WHEREAS, the election was held in the City of Long Beach on that day;

1 WHEREAS, the Los Angeles County Registrar-Recorder/County Clerk, duly
2 canvassed the returns of the election and has transmitted the results to the City Clerk;

3 NOW, THEREFORE, the City Council of the City of Long Beach does

A. Measure A: To maintain 911 emergency response services, police, fire, parks, libraries, repair streets, and support general services, shall an ordinance be adopted extending the City of Long Beach's Transactions and Use Tax beyond 2027, generating approximately \$60

1 million annually, at a 1% rate until December 31, 2022, at ¾% until
2 September 30, 2027, and at 1% from October 1, 2027 until ended by
3 voters, requiring a citizens' advisory committee and annual independent
4 audits, with all funds remaining in Long Beach?

5 B. Measure B: To provide funding for student arts education
6 programs, community arts, music, cultural programs and organizations,
7 local museums and theaters, and the Long Beach Convention and
8 Entertainment Center, and maintain other general fund programs shall a
9 measure be adopted increasing Long Beach's general transient occupancy
10 (hotel bed) tax rate from 6% to 7%, paid for by hotel/motel guests,
11 generating approximately \$2.8 million dollars annually, until ended by
12 voters, requiring audits and local control of funds?

13 Section 3. It is determined and declared that at the Special Municipal
14 Election, 49,676 votes were cast in favor of Measure A and 49,660 votes were cast
15 against it, and that it received a majority of the votes cast and that such proposition is
16 hereby approved.

17 Section 4. It is determined and declared that at the Special Municipal
18 Election, 59,190 votes were cast in favor of Measure B and 40,775 votes were cast
19 against it, and that it received a majority of the votes cast and that such proposition is
20 hereby approved.

21 Section 5. This resolution shall take effect immediately upon its adoption
22 by the City Council, and the City Clerk shall certify the vote adopting this resolution.
