RECOMMENDATION:

Authorize the City Manager to execute a public walkways occupancy permit with canopy and windbreak sidewalls for sidewalk dining at Smooth's Sports Grille located at 144 Pine Avenue. (District 2)

DISCUSSION

Pine Avenue S&G, LLC, the operator of Smooth's Sports Grille, located at 144 Pine Avenue, requested a first time permit to temporarily occupy part of the adjoining sidewalk with tables, chairs, a barrier and a permanent canopy with windbreak sidewalls. This restaurant was previously operated by Widnes, Inc., under the name "Mum's Restaurant".

The proposed permit area, the canopy details, and a list of furnishings and accessories to be placed in the permit area are shown on the attached Exhibit A. The special requirements for permit area canopies are attached as Exhibit B. Approval of this permit is based on the standards established by Chapter 14 of the Long Beach Municipal Code.

This permit request has been reviewed and approved by the Planning and Building Department and the Long Beach Fire Department. The canopy structure was approved during the initial canopy application process and the drawings are on file with the Planning and Building Department. The subject permit was prepared by Deputy City Attorney Lisa Peskay Malmsten.

Canopy Requirements and Description

Requirements

- 1. Permittee acknowledges that it is Permittee's obligation to comply with the requirements of the Fire, Health, and Planning & Building departments, including obtaining any separate permits required by those departments. In some cases, the requirements of those departments may limit the portion of the Permit Area that may be covered with a canopy, or whether a canopy can be permitted at all.
- 2. The dimensions of a proposed canopy over a Permit Area must be clearly indicated on Exhibit "A". All of the canopy, including the foundations, must be contained within the Permit Area.
- 3. A minimum clearance of 8 feet shall be provided underneath the canopy. Permission to place sidewalks or windbreaks shall be limited to November 1. though April 1.
- 4. No canopy shall be installed in such a manner or location as to enclose, obstruct or impair the usefulness of any street light of any informational, parking, or traffic control sign, or enclose any street tree.
- 5. No signage or advertisement may be added without the specific review and written approval of the Planning Bureau's Zoning Office and Director of Public Works.
- 6. When this permit is terminated or revoked, Permittee is responsible for removing the foundations and restoring the surface of the Permit Area to the satisfaction of the City. Should Permittee fail or refuse to remove the obstructions, the City may do so, and, in that event, the security deposit paid by Permittee shall be applied to the City's costs. Permittee shall reimburse the City or any costs in the excess of the security deposit.

Description of Permitted Canopy

- 1. The canopy shall be solid Crimson Red without pattern.
- 2. The canopy shall cover the entire permit area and shall be supported by five 2" square tube columns. The columns shall be located approximately 14 feet west of the property line.
