3 A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE
4 CITY OF LONG BEACH IMPLEMENTING GOVERNMENT
5 CODE SECTION 20636(c)(4) PURSUANT TO SECTION
6 20691 BY PAYING AND REPORTING THE VALUE OF
7 EMPLOYER PAID MEMBER CONTRIBUTIONS FOR
8 MISCELLANEOUS EMPLOYEES REPRESENTED BY THE
9 LONG BEACH ASSOCIATION OF ENGINEERING
10 EMPLOYEES TO THE CALIFORNIA PUBLIC EMPLOYEES'
11 RETIREMENT SYSTEM (CalPERS)

13 WHEREAS, the City of Long Beach has the authority to implement
14 Government Code Section 20636(c)(4) pursuant to Section 20691; and

15 WHEREAS, the City of Long Beach has a written labor policy or agreement
16 which specifically provides for the normal member contributions to be paid by the
17 employer, and reported as special compensation; and

18 WHEREAS, one of the steps in the procedures to implement this section is
19 the adoption by the governing body of the City of Long Beach of a resolution giving notice
20 of its intention to commence paying and reporting the value of employer paid member
21 contributions (EPMC) as compensation for all members of the group or class as identified
22 herein.

23 NOW, THEREFORE, the City Council of the City of Long Beach resolves as
24 follows:

25 Section 1. Effective as of February 26, 2011, the governing body of the
26 City of Long Beach shall implement Government Code Section 20636(c)(4) pursuant to
27 Section 20691 by paying and reporting the value of Employer Paid Member Contributions
28 (EPMC) for miscellaneous employees represented by the Long Beach Association of

1 Engineering Employees. This benefit shall consist of the City paying 6% of the normal
2 contributions as EPMC, and reporting the same percent value of compensation earnable,
3 excluding special compensation pursuant to Government Code Section 20636(c)(4) as
4 additional compensation. The employee shall pay 2% of the normal contribution.

5 Section 2. New City employees hired on or after February 26, 2011, who
6 are represented by the Long Beach Association of Engineering Employees shall pay
7 100% of the normal contributions and the City shall pay 0% of the normal contributions.


8 Section 3. This resolution shall take effect immediately upon its adoption
9 by the City Council, and the City Clerk shall certify the vote adopting this resolution.
