## RESOLUTION NO. RES-22-0170

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LONG BEACH AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO EXECUTE AN AGREEMENT WITH QUINN COMPANY TO PURCHASE A PAVING COMPACTOR AND A TANDEM VIBRATORY COMPACTOR, ON THE SAME TERMS AND CONDITIONS AFFORDED TO SOURCEWELL, A STATE OF MINNESOTA LOCAL GOVERNMENT UNIT AND SERVICE COOPERATIVE, THROUGH THEIR CONTRACT WITH CATERPILLAR, INC. IN A TOTAL AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED \$225,573

WHEREAS, the Charter of the City of Long Beach (the "City"), Section 1802, permits the City to purchase services, supplies, materials, equipment and labor with other government agencies by purchasing under their contracts on a voluntary and selective basis when authorized by resolution; and

WHEREAS, the City desires to purchase a paving compactor and a tandem vibratory compactor; and

WHEREAS, Sourcewell, a state of Minnesota local government unit and service cooperative, has a contract with Caterpillar, Inc. for the purchase of a paving compactor and a tandem vibratory compactor, Contract No. 032119-CAT ("Sourcewell Contract"); and

WHEREAS, Quinn Company is the only authorized local dealer for Caterpillar, Inc.; and

WHEREAS, the City's participation in the Sourcewell Contract will facilitate the City's ability to purchase the paving compactor and tandem vibratory compactor as well as provide considerable cost benefits to the City; and

1 WHEREAS, if the City had to utilize a formal bid process rather than 2 participate in the Sourcewell Contract, considerably more funds would be required; 3 NOW, THEREFORE, the City Council of the City of Long Beach resolves as 4 follows: 5 Section 1. The above recitals are true and correct and are incorporated 6 herein by this reference. 7 Section 2. The City Manager or designee is hereby authorized to enter an 8 agreement with Quinn Company to purchase a paving compactor and a tandem vibratory compactor, of the same type and kind identified in the Sourcewell Contract except as 9 10 modified by mutual agreement of the City and Quinn Company, and the purchase by the 11 City shall be on the same terms and conditions afforded to Sourcewell in a total amount not to exceed Two Hundred Twenty-Five Thousand Five Hundred Seventy-Three Dollars 12 13 (\$225,573), including tax and shipping, until Sourcewell Contract No. 032119-CAT expires 14 on May 13, 2023. 15 Section 3.
