1 FIRST AMENDMENT TO AGREEMENT NO. 29132

3 THIS FIRST AMENDMENT TO AGREEMENT NO. 29132 is made and
4 entered, in duplicate, as of February 28, 2008 for reference purposes only, pursuant to a
5 minute order adopted by the City Council of the City of Long Beach at its meeting held on
6 March 8, 2005, by and between BRYAN A. STIRRAT & ASSOCIATES, a California
7 corporation, with a place of business at 1360 Valley Vista Drive, Diamond Bar, California
8 91765 ("Consultant"), and the CITY OF LONG BEACH, a municipal corporation ("City").

9 WHEREAS, the parties entered Agreement No. 29132 whereby Consultant
10 agreed to provide unique skills to be performed in connection with As-Needed Landfill
11 and Environmental Project and Construction Management Services ("Project"); and

12 WHEREAS, the parties desire to extend the term of the Agreement and
13 adjust the Schedule of Charges;

14 NOW, THEREFORE, in consideration of the mutual terms and conditions
15 herein contained, the parties agree as follows:

16 1. Section 1.A. of Agreement No. 29132 is amended in its entirety to
17 read as follows:

18 "1. SCOPE OF WORK OR SERVICES.

19 A. Consultant shall furnish specialized services more particularly set
20 forth in Exhibit 'A', attached to the Agreement and incorporated by this reference,
21 in accordance with the standards of the profession, and City shall pay for said
22 services in the manner described below, not to exceed \$3,000,000.00 at the rates
23 or charges described in Exhibit 'A'. For the period from March 8, 2008 through
24 March 7, 2009, City shall pay to Consultant the rates identified in Consultant's
25 Schedule of Charges, attached hereto as Exhibit 'A-1'."

26 2. Section 2 of Agreement No. 29132 is amended in its entirety to read
27 as follows:

28 "2. TERM. The initial term of this Agreement shall commence at


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
1 midnight on March 8, 2005 and shall terminate at 11:59 p.m. on March 7, 2008. The first
2 extended term of this Agreement shall commence at midnight on March 8, 2008 and shall
3 terminate at 11:59 p.m. on March 7, 2009, unless sooner terminated as provided in this
4 Agreement, or unless the services to be performed hereunder or the Project is completed
5 sooner.

6 3. Except as expressly modified herein, all of the terms and conditions
7 contained in Agreement No. 29132 are ratified and confirmed and shall remain in full
8 force and effect.

9 IN WITNESS WHEREOF, the parties hereto have caused this document to
10 be duly executed with all formalities required by law as of the date first stated herein.




