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RESOLUTION NO. RES-18-0075

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE
CITY OF LONG BEACH ADOPTING A LIST OF PROJECTS
FOR FISCAL YEAR 2018-19 FUNDED BY SB 1: THE ROAD
REPAIR AND ACCOUNTABILITY ACT OF 2017

WHEREAS, Senate Bill 1 ("SB 1"), the Road Repair and Accountability Act
of 2017 (Chapter 5, Statutes of 2017) was passed by the Legislature and signed into law
by the Governor in April 2017 in order to address the significant multi-modal
transportation funding shortfalls statewide; and

WHEREAS, SB 1 includes accountability and transparency provisions that
will ensure the residents of the City of Long Beach, California ("City") are aware of the
projects proposed for funding in our community and which projects have been completed
each fiscal year; and

WHEREAS, the City must adopt a list of all projects proposed to receive
funding from the Road Maintenance and Rehabilitation Account ("RMRA"), created by SB
1 by resolution, which must include a description and the location of each proposed
project, a proposed schedule for the project's completion, and the estimated useful life of
the improvement; and

WHEREAS, the City will receive an estimated Eight Million Dollars
(\$8,000,000) in RMRA funding in fiscal year 2018-19 from SB 1; and

WHEREAS, this is the second year in which the City is receiving SB 1
funding and will enable the City to continue essential road maintenance and rehabilitation
projects, safety improvements, and increasing access and mobility options for the
traveling public that would not have otherwise been possible without SB 1; and

WHEREAS, the City has undergone a robust public process to ensure
public input into our community's transportation priorities/the project list; and

1 WHEREAS, the City used a Pavement Management System to develop the
 2 SB 1 project list to ensure revenues are being used on the most high-priority and cost-
 3 effective projects that also meet the communities priorities for transportation investment;
 4 and

5 WHEREAS, the funding from SB 1 will help the City maintain and
 6 rehabilitate many streets/roads, and add active transportation infrastructure throughout
 7 the City this year and similar projects into the future; and

8 WHEREAS, the 2016 California Statewide Local Streets and Roads Needs
 9 Assessment found that the City's streets and roads are in a "fair" condition and this
 10 revenue will help us maintain the "fair" condition; and

11 WHEREAS, the SB 1 project list and overall investment in our local streets
 12 and roads infrastructure with a focus on basic maintenance and safety, investing in
 13 complete streets infrastructure, and using cutting-edge technology, materials and
 14 practices, will have significant positive co-benefits statewide;

15 NOW, THEREFORE, the City Council of the City of Long Beach resolves as
 16 follows:

17 Section 1. The foregoing recitals are true and correct.

18 Section 2. The fiscal year 2018-19 list of projects planned to be funded
 19 with Road Maintenance and Rehabilitation Account revenues include the following:
