22. 20-0112 **REQUEST:**

The City Attorney requests that the attachment pertaining to Agenda Item No. 22 be distributed for the City Council meeting of February 18, 2020. Recommended action remains the same.

Recommendation to declare ordinance amending the Long Beach Municipal Code by amending Sections 8.63.020, 8.63.030, 8.63.050 and 8.63.070; all relating to prohibiting the use and sale of single-use food and beverage containers, packaging and food service ware made of expanded polystyrene (EPS) foam, rigid polystyrene #6, and non-recyclable and non-compostable material for prepared food distribution, and the distribution of plastic for bio-plastic straws, read and adopted as read.
