RECOMMENDATION:

Adopt Resolution declaring the results of the General Municipal Election held on June 5, 2018. (Citywide)

DISCUSSION

The City Attorney has prepared a resolution declaring the results of the General Municipal Election held on June 5, 2018, to elect members to City Council Districts 5 and 7, and adopt Measure M, Utility Revenue Transfer Charter Amendment. (Exhibit A).

As certified by the Los Angeles County Registrar-Recorder/County Clerk, the results are as follow:

Approval of the recommended action on July 10, 2018 will meet the provisions of California Elections Code Sections 10262 and 10263, and Long Beach Charter Section 200, which establishes the start of each Council Member term as commencing on the third Tuesday of July following the date of the election.

7 JUNE 5, 2018, TO SUBMIT TO A VOTE OF THE
8 QUALIFIED ELECTORS OF THE CITY ONE BALLOT
9 PROPOSITION AND TWO OFFICES ON THE CITY
10 COUNCIL FROM DISTRICTS 5 AND 7; AND DIRECTING
11 THE CITY CLERK TO ISSUE A CERTIFICATE OF
12 ELECTION TO THE CANDIDATES DECLARED TO HAVE
13 BEEN ELECTED AT THE GENERAL MUNICIPAL
14 ELECTION

16 WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Long Beach did, by Resolutions
17 Nos. RES-17-0128, RES-18-0063, RES-18-0064, duly call and provide for the holding of
18 a General Municipal Election on Tuesday, June 5, 2018, to submit to a vote of the
19 qualified electors of the City one (1) ballot proposition and two (2) offices on the City
20 Council from Districts 5 and 7; and

21 WHEREAS, the General Municipal Election was held in the city of Long
22 Beach on Tuesday, June 5, 2018; and

23 WHEREAS, the Los Angeles County Registrar duly canvassed the returns
24 of the election and has transmitted the results to the City Clerk;

25 NOW, THEREFORE, the City Council of the City of Long Beach resolves as
26 follows:

27 Section 1. A true and correct copy of the canvass of the votes cast in
28 Council Districts 5 and 7 and for and against the ballot proposition attached as Exhibit "A"

1 to this Resolution.

2 Section 2. The ballot proposition appeared on the ballot as follows:

3 Measure M: City of Long Beach Utility Revenue Transfer
4 Charter Amendment.

5 To maintain general City services like 9-1-1 emergency response,
6 police/fire protection, street/pothole repairs, senior services, parks
7 and libraries, shall the City of Long Beach amend its Charter to
8 authorize annual fund transfers from the City's water, sewer and
9 gas utilities to the General Fund not to exceed 12% of utility gross
10 revenues, generating approximately \$25,500,000 annually for
11 unrestricted general revenue purposes, requiring annual
12 independent audits, until ended by voters?

13 Section 3. That the candidates nominated as required by law for the
14 office of Member of the City Council from the Fifth District, and the names of the persons
15 voted for at the election were:

16 Stacy Mungo

17 Rich Dines

18 Section 4. That the candidates nominated as required by law for the
19 office of Member of the City Council from the Seventh District, and the names of the
20 persons voted for at the election were:

21 Roberto Uranga

22 Jared Milrad

23 Section 5. It is determined and declared that at the General Municipal
24 Election, 35,651 votes were cast in favor of Measure M and 30,659 votes were cast
25 against it, and that it received a majority of the votes cast and that such proposition is
26 hereby approved.

27 Section 6. That Stacy Mungo received a majority of the votes cast for all
28 candidates for the office of Member of the City Council from the Fifth District, and in

1 accordance with the provisions of law governing the nomination and/or election of
2 candidates for this office, Stacy Mungo is declared elected to the office of Member of the
3 City Council from the Fifth District for the full term of four (4) years commencing with the
4 third Tuesday of July, 2018. The City Clerk is directed to issue Stacy Mungo a Certificate
5 of Election certifying to the election to this office for such term.

6 Section 7. That Roberto Uranga received a majority of the votes cast for
7 all candidates for the office of Member of the City Council from the Seventh District, and
8 in accordance with the provisions of law governing the nomination and/or election of
9 candidates for this office, Roberto Uranga is declared elected to the office of Member of
10 the City Council from the Seventh District for the full term of four (4) years commencing
11 with the third Tuesday of July, 2018. The City Clerk is directed to issue Roberto Uranga
12 a Certificate of Election certifying to the election to this office for such term.

13 Section 8. This resolution shall take effect immediately upon its adoption
14 by the City Council, and the City Clerk shall certify the vote adopting this resolution.
