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3 A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE  
4 CITY OF LONG BEACH AUTHORIZING THE CITY  
5 MANAGER TO EXECUTE A CONTRACT WITH ACCELA,  
6 INC., WITHOUT ADVERTISING FOR BIDS, FOR  
7 SOFTWARE MAINTENANCE, LICENSING,  
8 PROFESSIONAL SERVICES AND REMOTE TECHNICAL  
9 ASSISTANCE FOR A PERIOD OF THREE YEARS WITH  
10 THE OPTION TO RENEW FOR TWO ADDITIONAL ONE-  
11 YEAR PERIODS IN AN ANNUAL AMOUNT NOT TO  
12 EXCEED \$210,000  
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14 WHEREAS, since 2011, the City has contracted with Accela, Inc. (Accela),  
15 formerly Decade Software Company, to provide environmental health inspection  
16 software, system maintenance, technical support, and professional services; and

17 WHEREAS, following a competitive bidding process in 2011, Decade  
18 Software was selected to provide the City with a software system known as Envision  
19 Connect to track environmental health inspections and related environmental health  
20 program compliance; and

21 WHEREAS, Envision Connect also enables the City to comply with the  
22 requirements of AB 2286, which requires all relevant public agencies and regulated  
23 hazardous waste generators to electronically file reporting data with the California  
24 Environmental Protection Agency (CalEPA); and

25 WHEREAS, the process of selecting a new vendor and converting the  
26 Envision Connect database over to a new platform would be a costly and staff-intensive  
27 project; and

28 WHEREAS, it would be economically beneficial to the City of Long Beach to

1 continue receiving software support, licensing, and software maintenance from Accela,  
2 Inc.; and

3 WHEREAS, the Health Department would like to enter into an annual  
4 contract for software maintenance, licensing, professional services and remote technical  
5 assistance with Accela, Inc.;

6 NOW, THEREFORE, the City Council of the City of Long Beach resolves as  
7 follows:

8 Section 1. The City Manager is hereby authorized to enter into a  
9 contract, without advertising for bids, with Accela, Inc., for software maintenance,  
10 licensing, professional services and remote technical assistance as may be required by  
11 the City for a period of three (3) years in an annual amount not to exceed Two Hundred  
12 Ten Thousand Dollars (\$210,000). The parties may, by mutual agreement, extend the  
13 term for two (2) additional periods of one (1) year each.

14 Section 2. This resolution shall take effect immediately upon its adoption  
15 by the City Council, and the City Clerk shall certify the vote adopting this resolution.
