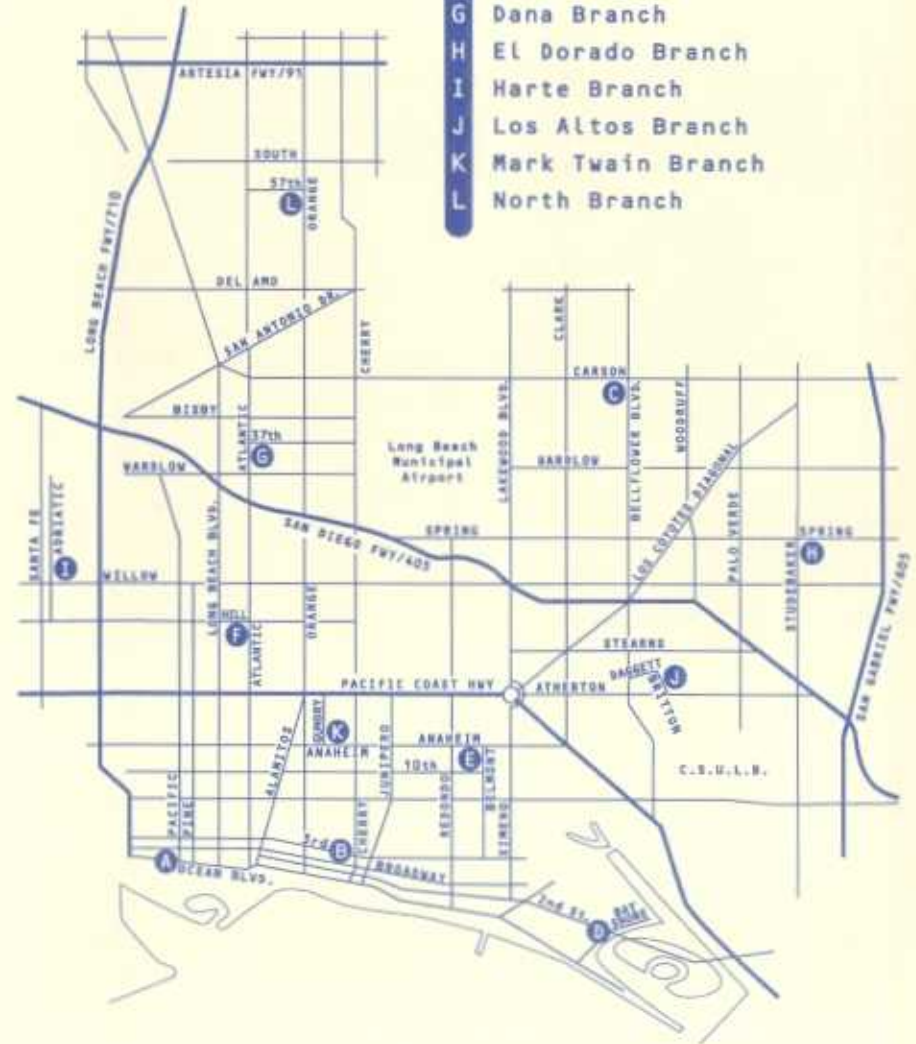

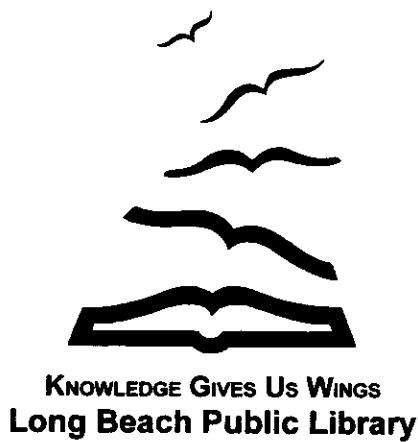

Enclosed with this letter is perhaps the most important tool your child will ever own during school years: his or her very own library card.

Every student should have the opportunity to know the excitement and the wonder of the world available at the library. That's why the City of Long Beach, the Long Beach Public Library and the Long Beach Unified School District have joined forces to make access to the library easier than ever.

Your child's teacher has given him or her an unactivated library card. All you have to do is:

- Fill out **and be sure to sign** the library card application.
- **Bring the application, the library card, and your child to your local public library.** Be sure to check the list of library hours included in this packet, and note any new hours at your neighborhood library.
- Select the level of information access that is best for your child by talking to library staff.

The library will activate the card on their new computer system -- and it's ready to use. It's that easy.

The new library card will open doors to **print materials and electronic resources** to help with homework assignments. The library offers **Internet access, Family Learning Centers**, and of course, **more than 1.2-million books**. The library is also offering an extra incentive: the first 3,000 children and parents to visit the library and activate the new library cards will receive "Kids Who Read Succeed" library card holders to wear around their necks.

We think reading is so important that this year we will put a library card just like this one into the hands of all first grade and kindergarten students who attend school in the Long Beach Unified School District. Our goal is simple, yet powerful: to create a lifelong interest in reading and learning. We know that kids who read succeed. Please join us and participate in this year's Library Card Campaign.

AN INVITATION TO EDUCATORS AND STUDENTS

Check with the librarians when preparing assignments that will require the use of public library materials.

Coordinate assignments with colleagues to stagger the demand for the same library materials by large numbers of students.

Allow students flexibility in fulfilling assignments based upon the availability of library resources.

Consider inviting the local librarian to the school's planning meetings, or having a staff member communicate with the librarian on a regular basis.

Bring to the library any assignment sheet distributed by the teacher.

Plan ahead — materials may be unavailable for any last-minute information searches.

Allow plenty of time for a library visit.

Classes and faculty are welcome to the library for an introductory visit or tour.

Programs for visits can be tailored to specific needs. Classes may view films, listen to stories, receive library skill instruction, and/or check out library materials. Faculty groups may request orientation tours or presentations on library resources.

Please telephone in advance to make an appointment. If your group cannot keep an appointment, please call and cancel. Time is reserved for your group, and the librarians spend time in preparation.

HOW TO GET A LIBRARY CARD

Library cards are free and easy to obtain. Adults (18 and over) fill out an application form and present personal identification showing their current address. Children and teens must have a youth application signed by a parent/guardian. Preschool children receive a special library card. Library patrons do not need to live in Long Beach to apply for a library card. The card is valid at all twelve library sites.

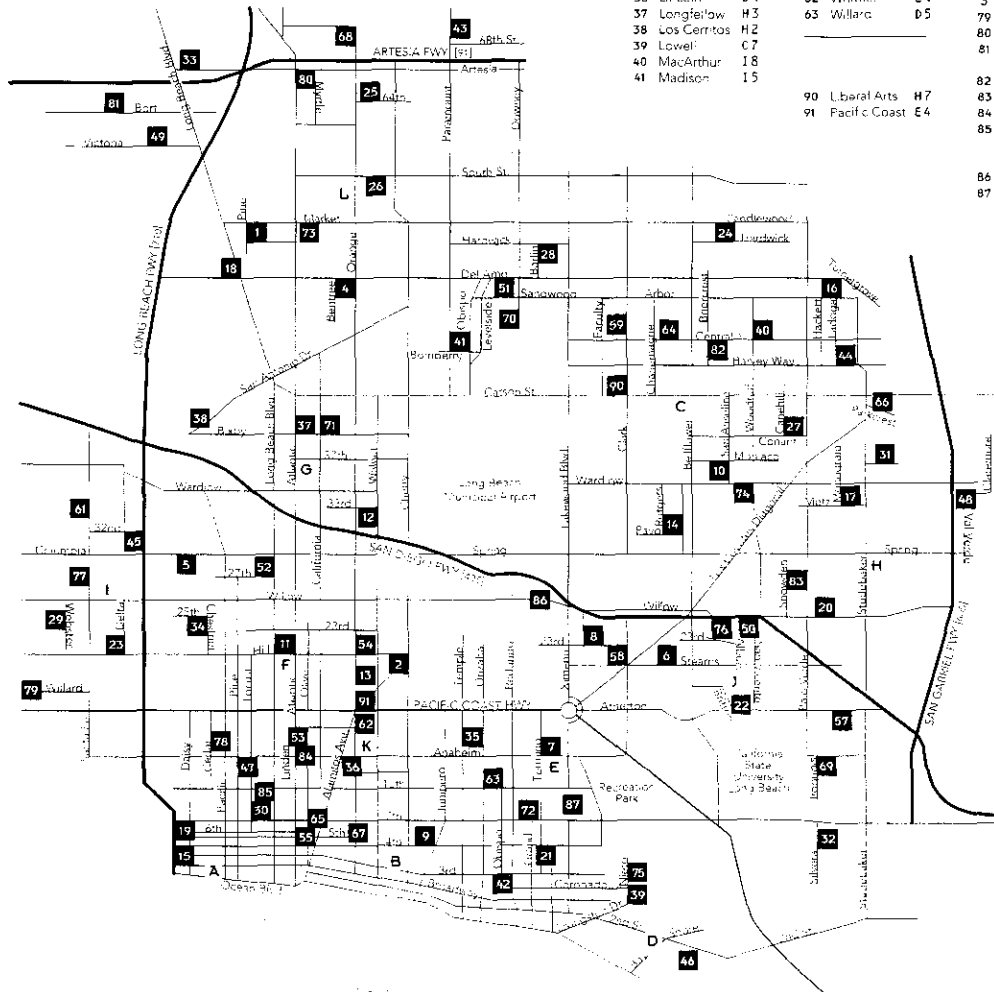
