RECOMMENDATION:

Authorize the City Manager to execute an agreement, and any subsequent amendments, in the amount of \$1,852,026 for a period of three years, with the County of Los Angeles to provide alcohol and drug abuse rehabilitation services. (Citywide)

DISCUSSION

Since 1967, the City of Long Beach Department of Health and Human Services (Health Department), Human and Social Services Bureau has provided alcohol and drug treatment and recovery services under contract with the County of Los Angeles. These programs provide education, direct counseling, group therapy, community outreach and prevention services to substance abusers and their families in the greater Long Beach area. In addition, the Students Talking About Resisting Substances (STARS) program provides drug abuse prevention services to youth between the ages of 10 to 14 and works in cooperation with substance abuse professionals, probation schools, social service providers, youth and parents to actively engage in the prevention of alcohol and other drug use and the avoidance of violence.

The current agreement ended on June 30, 2006. In order to continue to provide services, the new agreement needs to be executed for three years for numbers 1 through 4 below, and 1 year for numbers 5 and 6 below, as required by the County. The contracts to be executed are as follows:

Sufficient funding has been budgeted in the Health Fund (SR 130) and in the Department of Health and Human Services (HE) for FY 06. Appropriations for FY 07 are included in the FY 07 proposed budget. Final appropriations will be completed as part of the FY 08 budget process.
