## **CONTRACT**

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THIS CONTRACT is made and entered, in duplicate, as of January 1, 2015 for reference purposes only, pursuant to Resolution No. RES-14-0119, adopted by the City Council of the City of Long Beach at its meeting on December 16, 2014, by and between THE BOLDER GROUP, INC. ("Contractor"), a California corporation, located at 227 Marina Drive, Long Beach, California 90803 and the CITY OF LONG BEACH ("City"), a municipal corporation.

WHEREAS, City did by Resolution No. RES-14-0119 determine that the City's need to purchase marine fuel and related supplies could only be met by Contractor and, by reason of the foregoing, no useful purpose would be served by advertising for bids to purchase such marine fuel and related supplies;

NOW, THEREFORE, in consideration of the mutual terms and conditions contained herein, the parties agree as follows:

- 1. Contractor shall sell, furnish and deliver to City marine fuel and related supplies as authorized by Resolution No. RES-14-0119.
- 2. City shall pay Contractor in due course of payments for the marine fuel and related supplies a sum not to exceed \$150,000, plus a 10 percent (10%) contingency for a total amount of \$165,000 annually, including tax with the option to renew for three (3) additional one-year periods, at the discretion of the City Manager.
- 3. The term of this Contract shall commence at midnight on January 1, 2015, and shall terminate on December 31, 2015. The parties may, by mutual agreement, extend the term for three (3) additional periods of one (1) year each.
- 4. Neither this Contract nor any of the moneys that may become due Contractor hereunder may be assigned without the prior written consent of City.
- 5. Any notices required hereunder or desired to be given by either party shall be in writing and personally delivered or deposited in the U.S. Postal Service, first class postage prepaid, addressed to Contractor at the address stated herein, and to City

### RESOLUTION NO. RES-14-0119

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LONG BEACH AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO EXECUTE A CONTRACT WITH THE BOLDER GROUP, INC., WITHOUT ADVERTISING FOR BIDS, FOR FURNISHING AND DELIVERING MARINE FUEL FOR A PERIOD OF ONE YEAR WITH THE OPTION TO RENEW FOR THREE ADDITIONAL ONE-YEAR PERIODS IN AN ANNUAL AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED \$150,000

WHEREAS, the recent addition of grant-funded marine vessels has increased the size of the City's fleet and caused the cost of supplying said fleet Marine Fuel to exceed \$100,000 per year; and

WHEREAS, The Bolder Group, Inc. is currently under Lease Agreement No. 28350 with the Department of Parks, Recreation and Marine to manage the fuel docs at Alamitos Bay and Shoreline Marina; and

WHEREAS, The Bolder Group, Inc. provides marine fuel to the public and manages the docks owned by the City; and

WHEREAS, it would not be economically beneficial to the City of Long Beach to divide the fuel tanks located at the docks between the public and City users; and

WHEREAS, therefore, the Department of Financial Management would like to enter into an annual contract to purchase marine fuel from The Bolder Group, Inc. to simplify fuel delivery and management of fuel operations at the fuel docks;

NOW, THEREFORE, the City Council of the City of Long Beach resolves as follows:

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Section 1. The City Manager is hereby authorized to enter into a contract, without advertising for bids, with The Bolder Group, Inc. for the purchase of marine fuel as may be required by the City for a period of one (1) year in an annual amount not to exceed One Hundred Fifty Thousand Dollars (\$150,000) and an additional 10 percent (10%) contingency in the amount of Fifteen Thousand Dollars (\$15,000) for a total annual amount not to exceed \$165,000. The parties may, by mutual agreement, extend the term for three (3) additional periods of one (1) year each. This resolution shall take effect immediately upon its adoption Section 2. by the City Council, and the City Clerk shall certify the vote adopting this resolution.
