FIRST AMENDMENT TO PERMIT NO. 35570

THIS FIRST AMENDMENT TO PERMIT NO. 35570 is made and entered, as of December 29, 2022 for reference purposes only, pursuant to a minute order adopted by the City Council of the City of Long Beach at its meeting on December 10, 2019, by and between DOCKSIDE BOAT & BED, INC., a California corporation ("Permittee"), whose business address is 316 E. Shoreline Drive, Long Beach, California 90802, and the CITY OF LONG BEACH, a municipal corporation ("City").

WHEREAS, City requires specialized services requiring unique skills to be performed in connection with operating bed and breakfast inn accommodations and charters at Rainbow Harbor, Dock 5; and

WHEREAS, City and Permittee (the "Parties") entered into Permit No. 35570 (the "Permit") whereby Permittee agreed to provide these services; and

WHEREAS, the Parties desire to extend the permit for one (1) additional period of three (3) years;

NOW, THEREFORE, in consideration of the mutual terms, covenants, and conditions herein contained, the Parties agree as follows:

- 1. Section 3 of the Permit is hereby amended to read as follows.
- "3. <u>TERM</u>: The term of this Permit shall commence at 12:01 a.m. on January 1, 2020 and shall terminate at midnight on December 31, 2025. Notwithstanding the foregoing, either party may terminate this Permit at any time for any or no reason upon ninety (90) days' written notice to the other party. Upon termination of this Permit (whether by lapse of time or otherwise), Permittee shall quit and surrender possession of the Permit Area and remove its personal property therefrom. The term of this permit may be extended beyond December 31, 2025, for one (1) additional period of three (3) years at the sole discretion of the City Manager of the City of Long Beach or designee."
- 2. Except as expressly modified herein, all of the terms and conditions contained in Permit No. 35507 are ratified and confirmed and shall remain in full force and
