RECOMMENDATION:

Receive the supporting documentation into the record, conclude the hearing and grant a One-Year Short-Term permit with conditions for an entertainment permit with dancing by patrons at Frisco's Food Services, Inc., DBA Frisco's Restaurant, 4750 Los Coyotes Diagonal. (District 4)

DISCUSSION

The Long Beach Municipal Code (LBMC) requires an application be filed and a hearing be held before the City Council whenever this type of activity is requested and before a permit is granted or denied.

The LBMC also requires that the City Council make a determination that the application is complete and truthful; the applicant, the person interested in the ownership and operation of the entity, and the officers and trustees of the entity are law-abiding persons who will operate and conduct the business activity in a lawful manner; and, that the public peace, welfare, and safety will not be impaired. If this is so, the application shall be approved; if not, it shall be denied.

Attached for your review is the application from Frisco's Food Services, Inc., DBA Frisco's Restaurant. Also attached are reports from various departments and a summary of those reports, as well as the license history of the establishment.

City departments have conducted their investigation in accordance with the LBMC. The following summarizes their findings:

- The Police Department recommends that the permit for entertainment with dancing by patrons be approved as a One-Year Short-Term permit with conditions.
- The Fire Department recommends that the permit for entertainment with dancing by patrons be approved.

- The Health and Human Services Department finds that the building/location meets department requirements for the proposed use with the condition that the establishment remain in compliance with the Long Beach Noise Ordinance (LBMC Chapter 8.80).
- The Planning and Building Department recommends that the permit for entertainment with dancing by patrons be approved.

In the event that any of the recommended conditions attached to any permit or licenses are in conflict, the permittee shall adhere to the strictest of the applicable conditions. This location has been licensed as a restaurant since January 2006.

TIMING CONSIDERATIONS

The hearing date of February 12, 2008, has been posted on the business location, with the applicant and property owners within 300 feet notified by mail.

This matter was reviewed by Deputy City Attorney Cristyl Meyers on January 29, 2008.

FISCAL IMPACT



In response to your request for a recommendation regarding the above named permit application for Entertainment With Dancing, the Police Department recommends **approval** of a **one-year short-term** permit, subject to the following eighteen (18) conditions of operation:

Because of strong concern regarding increased crowds and potential late night noise problems in the parking lot and the neighboring residential area, the Vice Investigations Section believes that a one-year short-term permit, with specific conditions to address documented problems, would better serve the community. After a year of operation with the below conditions, a new application may be submitted for evaluation.

CONDITIONS OF OPERATION

- 1) The operation of the establishment shall be limited to those activities and elements expressly indicated on the permit application and approved by the City Council. Any change in the operation, which exceeds the conditions of the approved permit, will require that a new permit application be submitted to the City Council for their review and approval.
- 2) Unless separately applied for, reviewed, and approved, no adult entertainment, as defined by section 5.72.115(B) LBMC shall be conducted on the permitted premises.
- 3) Entertainment activities indicated on page #7 of your entertainment application shall be restricted to no later than 12 midnight Sunday through Thursday nights, and 1:00 a.m. on Friday and Saturday nights.
- 4) Noise emanating from the permittee's premises shall not be audible 50 feet or more from the exterior of the premises. The permittee shall be responsible for determining how to best meet this requirement, either by keeping doors and windows shut, limiting hours of entertainment or by offering non-amplified entertainment.
- 5) All entertainment activities shall be conducted in conjunction with regular dining or pre-planned banquet activities. A banquet is defined as a private function held at a bona fide eating-place wherein complete and substantial meals are provided to the persons in attendance by the management of the restaurant where the function is being held. Fast food, snacks and hors d'oeuvres shall not constitute a complete and substantial meal.

- 6) The permittee shall not hire promoters with the intent to advertise/promote or hold any entertainment activities consistent with nightclub entertainment.
- 7) The permittee shall not allow employees to discard trash or beer bottles into the outside dumpster between the hours of 10 p.m. and 7 a.m.
- 8) During any entertainment activity listed on page #7 of the application, the permittee shall be responsible for maintaining an adequate security staff to supervise patrons inside the establishment and the parking lot. For crowds up to fifty (50) people, the permittee shall provide a minimum of one (1) security guard. For crowds over (50) fifty people, the permittee shall provide a minimum of one (1) additional security guard per fifty (50) people. Security guards must be identifiable as "Frisco's employees." Should the permittee's operations give rise to a substantial increase in complaints/calls for service, or trash left in the parking lot, the permittee shall increase staff, or employee uniformed licensed security guards, as directed by the Chief of Police.
- 9) On any night where organizations, such as car clubs, motorcycle clubs, or any organization who may congregate in the parking lot, the permittee shall staff one (1) security guard, in the parking lot, between the hours of 9 p.m. and ½ hour after closing. Security Guards shall ensure that patrons conduct themselves in a peaceful manner as not to disturb any nearby residents. Security Guards must be identifiable as "Frisco's employees." The Chief of Police may increase or relax this condition, based on calls for service related to problems in the parking lot.
- 10) There shall be no "queue" allowed at anytime. A queue is defined as persons awaiting entry after the business is at capacity.
- 11) The permittee shall take reasonable measures to prohibit and prevent the loitering of persons immediately outside any of the entrance/exit doors and the parking lot, at all times while open for business. This should be done by use of security guards and signage indicating, words to the effect of, "Please respect our neighbors."
- 12) At the conclusion of each event, the permittee shall take reasonable measures to ensure that exiting patrons walk directly to their vehicles, and not loiter in the parking lot or the immediate area.
- 13) Current occupancy loads shall be posted at all times, and the permittee shall have an effective system to keep count of the number of occupants present at any given time and provide that information to public safety personnel upon request. (LBMC section 18.48.320)

- 14) The permittee agrees to reimburse the City whenever excessive police services, as determined by the Chief of Police, are required as the result of any incident or nuisance arising out of or in connection with the permittee's operations.
- 15) Frisco's, or its agents, shall not distribute any advertising matter such as signs, posters, or promotional cards, in or upon any public property, or in or on any vehicle in any such place in the City. Distribution of any advertising matter upon private property shall adhere to the following guidelines: By placing the same matter in a receptacle, clip, or other device designed or intended to receive advertising matter.
- 16) This Entertainment Permit is accessory to the primary business, which is a restaurant. In the event the primary business ceases operations on a permanent basis, meaning meals are no longer offered at the location period, the entertainment permit becomes null and void.
- 17) The permittee shall maintain full compliance with all applicable laws, ABC laws, ordinances and stated conditions. In the event of a conflict with the requirements of this permit, the more stringent regulation shall apply.
- 18) The permittee, shall, within ninety (90) days of an approved entertainment permit, submit proof of attending the LEAD program offered by the Department of Alcoholic Beverage Control. In the event that the LEAD program class is not offered within this ninety day period, the permittee shall attend the next available class. Proof of completion shall be submitted to the Long Beach Police Department Vice Investigations Section.

The Community Design and Development Division of the Department of Planning and Building has the following comments:

In 2003, the Planning Commission approved a Conditional Use Permit and Site Plan Review for this location to allow the expansion of an existing restaurant with on-premises sales of alcoholic beverages and a fixed bar. Per the staff report and conditions of approval for this case (Case No. 0309-04), no additional parking was required due to the 655 total parking spaces shared by all tenants of the Circle Center Shopping Center. Though no additional parking was required, as a result of the expansion and remodel of the existing restaurant, seven (7) additional parking spaces were created bringing the total number of spaces in the shopping center to 662.

The applicant is proposing a 360 square foot dance floor. The parking requirement for a dance floor area is 25 spaces per 1,000 square feet, resulting in a need for 9 additional parking spaces based on the size of the proposed dance floor. The area proposed for the dance floor is currently being utilized for dining area and a dance area for non-patrons, which requires 4 parking spaces. Given that the area for the proposed dance floor currently has 4 parking spaces allocated to it and the restaurant had an additional 7 spaces at the time of the original approvals, no additional parking is required for the proposed dance floor.

Planning Bureau recommends that the entertainment permit with dancing for "Frisco's Restaurant" be approved.
