In-Home Supportive Services (I.H.S.S.) providers provide vital care to those in need and save taxpayers millions of dollars each year. While the hard work of in-home caregivers often goes unnoticed, the number of family and non-family members requiring in-home care is expected to double in the next 30 years.

WHEREAS, in order to meet the future demands of caregiving we must ensure a stable workforce by recognizing today the important contributions In-Home Caregivers bring to those receiving care, to our communities and to society as a whole,

WHEREAS, the month of November is designated as National Family
Caregivers Month, it offers the perfect opportunity to highlight the hard work, dedication
and courage to care that all In-Home Caregivers exemplify everyday – in caring for both
