HONORABLE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL City of Long Beach California

RECOMMENDATION:

Adopt a Resolution establishing an annual special tax of \$0.12 per square foot for Community Facilities District No. 2007-2 for commercial properties in Belmont Shore for Fiscal Year 2014 and authorizing the Los Angeles County Auditor-Controller to include on the 2013-14 Secured Tax Roll. (District 3)

DISCUSSION

In August 2008, the City Council approved and adopted the formation of Community Facilities District 2007-2 (CFD 2007-2) in Belmont Shore. CFD 2007-2 replaced CFD 1 (District) to allow for bond issuance, acquire property and to confirm revisions to district boundaries. In December 2009, the City issued bonds under CFD 2007-2, which repaid the 1993 Belmont Shore Parking Meter Revenue bonds and pledged parking meter revenues to the Belmont Shore CFD bond.

The District was initially formed in 1988 for the purpose of funding additional public parking. Since Fiscal Year 2006 (FY 06), the levy has been set at \$0.12 cents per commercial lot square foot. Annually, the Belmont Shore Parking and Business Improvement Area Commission (BSPBIA) recommends to the City Council the annual levy for the District. At that time, the City Council is asked to adopt a Resolution establishing the special tax levy. At its meeting of June 20, 2013, the BSPBIA recommended that the levy again be set at \$0.12 per square foot of commercial properties.

This matter was reviewed by Assistant City Attorney Michael Mais and Budget Management Officer Victoria Bell on June 20, 2013.

TIMING CONSIDERATIONS

City Council action is requested on July 16, 2013, as the Los Angeles County Auditor-Controller requires the assessment roll by July 31, 2013.

FISCAL IMPACT

The District levy is estimated to generate \$59,027 in FY 14. This amount will be included in the FY 14 Budget in the Agency Special Assessment Fund (AS) in the Assessment Districts and Community Facilities Department (XE). There is no impact to the General Fund and no local job impact associated with this recommendation.

RESOLUTION NO.

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LONG BEACH ESTABLISHING ANNUAL SPECIAL TAX FOR COMMUNITY FACILITIES DISTRICT NO. 2007-2 (BELMONT SHORE) FOR FISCAL YEAR 2013-2014

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Long Beach (hereinafter referred to as the "legislative body") initiated proceedings, held a public hearing, conducted an election and received a favorable vote from the qualified electors relating to the levy of a special tax in a community facilities district, all as authorized pursuant to the terms and provisions of the "Mello-Roos Community Facilities Act of 1982", being Chapter 2.5, Part 1 of Division 2, Title 5 of the Government Code of the State of California. This Community Facilities District shall hereinafter be referred to as Community Facilities District No. 2007-2 (Belmont Shore) (hereinafter referred to as the "District"); and

16 WHEREAS, at this time, bonds have been authorized for issuance in the 17 amount of four million dollars; and

18 WHEREAS, this legislative body, by ordinance as authorized by Section 19 53340 of the Government Code of the State of California, has authorized the levy of a 20 special tax to pay for costs and expenses related to said Community Facilities District, 21 and this legislative body is desirous to establish the specific rate of the special tax to be 22 collected for the next fiscal year;

23 NOW, THEREFORE, the City Council of the City of Long Beach resolves as 24 follows:

25 Section 1. That the above recitals are all true and correct. 26 Section 2. That the specific rate and amount of the special tax to be 27 collected to pay for the costs and expenses for the next fiscal year (2013-2014) for the 28 referenced District is hereby determined and established as set forth in the attached,

1 || referenced and incorporated Exhibit "A".

Section 3. That the rate as set forth above does not exceed the amount
as previously authorized by ordinance of this legislative body, and is not in excess of that
as previously approved by the qualified electors of the District.

5 Section 4. The proceeds of the special tax shall be used to pay, in whole
6 or in part, the costs of the following, in the following order of priority:

A. Payment of principal of and interest on any outstanding authorized bonded indebtedness;

B. Necessary replenishment of bond reserve funds or other reserve funds;

C. Payment of costs and expenses of authorized public facilities;

D. Repayment of advance and loans, if appropriate.

13The proceeds of the special taxes shall be used as set forth above, and14shall not be used for any other purpose.

Section 5. The special tax shall be collected in the same manner as
ordinary ad valorem property taxes are collected, and shall be subject to the same
penalties and same procedure and sale in cases of any delinquency for ad valorem
taxes, and the Tax Collector is hereby authorized to deduct reasonable administrative
costs incurred in collecting any said special tax.

Section 6. All monies above collected shall be paid into the Community
Facilities District funds, including any bond fund and reserve fund.

Section 7. The Auditor of the County is hereby directed to enter in the
next County assessment roll on which taxes will become due, opposite each lot or parcel
of land affected in a space marked "public improvements, special tax" or by any other
suitable designation, the installment of the special tax, and for the exact rate and amount
of said tax, reference is made to the attached Exhibit "A".

Section 8. The County Auditor shall then, at the close of the tax
collection period, promptly render to this Agency a detailed report showing the amount

and/or amounts of such special tax installments, interest, penalties and percentages so
 collected and from what property collected, and also provide a statement of any
 percentages retained for the expense of making any such collection.

Section 9. This resolution shall take effect immediately upon its adoption
by the City Council, and the City Clerk shall certify the vote adopting this resolution.
