

RESOLUTION NO. RES-19-0160

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LONG BEACH, CALIFORNIA, REQUESTING THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OF THE COUNTY OF LOS ANGELES TO RENDER SPECIFIED SERVICES TO THE CITY RELATING TO THE CONDUCT OF A PRIMARY NOMINATING ELECTION TO BE HELD ON TUESDAY, MARCH 3, 2020 AND A GENERAL MUNICIPAL ELECTION TO BE HELD ON TUESDAY, NOVEMBER 3, 2020

WHEREAS, a Primary Nominating Election and a General Municipal Election are to be held in the City of Long Beach, California on March 3, 2020 and November 3, 2020, respectively; and

WHEREAS, in the course of conduct of these elections, it will be necessary for the City to request services of the County; and

WHEREAS, all necessary expenses in performing this service shall be paid by the City of Long Beach;

NOW, THEREFORE, the City Council of the City of Long Beach resolves as follows:

Section 1. That pursuant to the provisions of Section 10002 of the Elections Code of the State of California, the City Council requests the Board of Supervisors of the County to permit the Los Angeles County Registrar-Recorder/County Clerk to prepare and furnish full election services for use in conducting the elections.

These services include, but are not limited to:

- A. County consolidation of election precincts into City voting precincts, and maps of the voting precincts;
- B. Recruitment of vote centers and training of poll workers;
