A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LONG BEACH AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER OR HIS DESIGNEE, INCLUDING THE ASSISTANT CITY MANAGER OR THE CITY ENGINEER, TO SUBMIT AN APPLICATION TO CALRECYCLE FOR A RUBBERIZED PAVEMENT GRANT AND TO EXECUTE ALL DOCUMENTS NECESSARY TO ACCEPT FUNDS AND IMPLEMENT THE PROGRAM

WHEREAS, Public Resources Code sections 4800 et seq. authorize the Department of Resources Recycling and Recovery ("CalRecycle") to administer various grant programs ("grants") in furtherance of the State of California's efforts to reduce, recycle and reuse solid waste generated in the state thereby preserving landfill capacity and protecting public health and safety and the environment; and

WHEREAS, CalRecycle offers the Rubberized Pavement Grant Program to promote the use of rubberized pavement products derived from recycled California generated waste tires; and

WHEREAS, the City of Long Beach desires to participate in said Program by applying for any grant for which it is eligible; and

WHEREAS, in furtherance of this authority, CalRecycle is required to establish procedure governing the application, awarding, and management of the grants; and

WHEREAS, CalRecycle grant application procedures require, among other things, an applicant's governing body to declare by resolution certain authorizations related to the administration of CalRecycle grants;
